

Centre to sign pact with TERI for institute for energy transition

- The Union Power Ministry to sign a memorandum of agreement with The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) for setting up an institute for energy transition at TERI campus in Hyderabad.
- In India, 44 per cent of the country's power generation capacity is from non-fossil sources. In actual physical terms, about 180,000 plus megawatts is the non-fossil capacity.
- The nuclear capacity is just about 7,800 megawatts. The remaining is totally renewable.
- That constitutes 44 per cent of the established capacity, 427,000 megawatts out of which 180,000 MW is renewable.
- India by 2030, that it would have 40 percent of our power generation capacity as renewables.
- India in COP26 that by 2030 to have 50 per cent of capacity from non-fossil sources, mostly renewables.
- India's per capita emission is among the lowest in the world.

BIMSTEC Aquatics Championships: Host India wins overall trophy, team Thailand comes second

- first BIMSTEC Aquatics Championships 2024 concluded with Team India taking the overall trophy with 360 points.
- The Indian swimmers who won a total of 19 Gold medals also took the men's and women's champion trophies and the Men and Women's diving teams also winning Diving champions trophies.
- Trophies for Best Swimmer Male were given to India's Harsh Saroha for winning 3 Gold Medals and Best Swimmer Female to Thailand's Maria Anedelko for winning 3 Gold and 1 Silver.
- Team Thailand meanwhile won the Men and Women's Water Polo Championship trophies
- The competitions, which were being hosted participants of the 20 and under age category had events in Swimming, Water Polo and Diving.
- A total of 43 events took place across 3 aquatics disciplines, with 9 trophies including overall champions being given out.
- Over 268 athletes from various member countries participated in the event.

ADB And Government Of India Sign \$200 Million Loan For Brahmaputra River Project

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved a \$200 million loan to strengthen flood and riverbank erosion risk management along the 650 kilometers (km) long main stem of the Brahmaputra River in Assam, India.
- The project builds on the success and lessons from the ADB-financed Assam Integrated Flood and Riverbank Erosion Risk Management Investment Program (2010–2020) and similar investments in Bangladesh and will continue to tackle recurrent flooding and continual riverbank erosion of the Brahmaputra River.
- The project will apply a holistic, integrated, and risk-informed approach to scale up investment in flood and riverbank erosion risk management and its long-term planning, while intensifying support for climate and disaster resilience and food security.
- By optimizing co-benefits and empowering women through disaster-resilient economic activities, the project will benefit about 1 million people and increase crop production over 50,000 hectares.
- By stabilizing 60 km of banks, installing 32 km of pro-siltation measures, and building 4 km of climate-resilient flood embankments in five high-priority districts (Dibrugarh, Goalpara, Kamrup Rural, Morigaon, and Tinsukia), the project will secure living spaces, support livelihoods, create employment opportunities, and ultimately enhance the navigability of the river.

Reliance Consumer to acquire Ravalgaon Sugar confectionery brands

- Reliance Consumer will acquire Ravalgaon Sugar confectionery's brands, including Coffee Break and Paan Pasand, in a ₹27 crore deal.
- Ravalgaon Sugar Farm, which owns brands such as Mango Mood, Coffee Break, Tutty Fruity, Paan Pasand, Choco Cream and Supreme, has sold its trademarks, recipes, all intellectual property rights to Reliance Consumer Products Ltd (RCPL).
- Approved the sale, transfer and assignment of the trademarks, recipes, all intellectual property rights, including all rights, interests, and protections associated therewith, relating to the company's sugar-boiled confectionery business to RCPL for a consideration of ₹27 crores.
- A deed of assignment by its promoters Harshavardhan Bharat Doshi, Nihal Harshavardhan Doshi, and Lalan Ajay Kapadi has also been executed.
- RCPL is a subsidiary of Reliance Retail Ventures Ltd (RRVL), which is the retail arm of Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries Ltd.
- Recently RCPL had launched its consumer packaged goods brand 'Independence'.
- Before this, Reliance had acquired the home-grown soft drink brand Campa.

Neeraj Chopra Honoured At Jungfrau's Ice Palace In Switzerland

- Olympic and World champion javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra has been honoured with a plaque at the famous Ice Palace at Jungfraujoch, known as the 'Top of Europe', in Switzerland.
- Chopra donated one of his javelins to the tourist attraction and it has been placed alongside the plaque.
- He joins stars such as Roger Federer, and golfer Rory McIlroy, who also have such commemorative plaques at the Ice Palace.
- The Wall of Fame at Jungfraujoch serves as a testament to the spirit of accomplishment and dedication.
- He had earlier gifted a javelin to the Olympic Museum in Switzerland.

Neeraj Chopra:

- Neeraj Chopra is an Indian track and field athlete, who is the reigning Olympic champion and World champion in Men's javelin throw.
- He is the first Asian athlete to win an Olympic gold medal in javelin and the first Asian to win gold in his event at the World Championship.

Two independent directors quit Paytm Payments Bank board

- Two independent directors have resigned from the board of Paytm Payments Bank.
- Shinjini Kumar and Manju Agarwal have quit the firm's board.
- Kumar has previously held senior positions in organisations like Citibank, PwC India and Bank of America Merrill Lynch.
- Manju Agarwal has also served as the Deputy Managing Director at SBI and was a part of PPBL board since May 2021.
- The bank's board now comprises three independent directors former Punjab & Sind Bank executive director Arvind Kumar Jain, former Accenture MD Pankaj Vaish, and former DPIIT secretary Ramesh Abhishek.
- Paytm Bank board alerted by RBI on non-compliance-

JSW, Odisha govt tie up for Rs 40K cr integrated EV manufacturing facility

- JSW Group has signed an agreement with the Odisha government to set up an integrated EV manufacturing facility in the state entailing an investment of Rs 40,000 crore.
- The \$23 billion Group is into core sectors like steel, energy, cement, infrastructure, paints, ventures, and sports.
- The project, with an investment of Rs 40,000 crore, will help create over 11,000 jobs, marking a significant growth in employment generation in the state.
- The project consists of a 50 GWH EV battery plant, EVs, lithium refinery, copper smelter and related component manufacturing units.

Sunrisers claim back-to-back SA20 titles, thrash DSG in finals

- In a thrilling finale to the SA20 2024 tournament, Sunrisers Eastern Cape emerged victorious with a commanding win over Durban Super Giants.
- The final, held at Newlands in Cape Town, showcased a display of exceptional cricket from the defending champions, who secured their second consecutive title in style.
- Choosing to bat first after winning the toss, Sunrisers Eastern Cape put up a formidable total of 204 runs for the loss of three wickets in their allotted 20 overs. Tom Abell (55) and Tristan Stubbs (56 not out) were the standout performers with the bat, scoring half-centuries with finesse and guiding their team to a commanding position
- Chasing a challenging target of 205 runs, Durban Super Giants struggled to counter the formidable bowling attack of Sunrisers Eastern Cape. The Orange Army's bowlers delivered a disciplined performance, restricting the Super Giants to just 115 runs in 17 overs. All-rounder Marco Jansen starred with the ball, claiming an impressive five-wicket haul to dismantle the opposition's batting lineup.
- Durban's Super Giants, Joburg Super Kings, MI Cape Town, Paarl Royals, Pretoria Capitals and Sunrisers Eastern Cape were the teams battling for the SA20 2024 title.
- Ryan Rickelton (MICT) top scored with 530 runs in 10 matches.
- Marco Johnson (SEC) finished on top with 20 wickets in 10 matches.
- SA20 2024 Winner Prize Money: The winning team of the South Africa T20 League will receive 34 million Rand as prize money, which translates to approximately Rs 15 crore in Indian currency.
- SA20 2024 Runner-Up Prize Money: The runner-up team in SA20 Final of the South Africa T20 League for the year 2024 will receive 16.25 million Rand as prize money. This amount is approximately Rs 7.2 crore when converted to Indian currency.

Ex-Brazil striker Diego Souza announces retirement

- Former Brazil international striker Diego Souza has announced his retirement from professional football, drawing the curtains on a remarkable career that spanned over 20 years.
- The 38-year-old had been without a club since December, when he parted ways with Sport Recife, where he had been on loan from Brazilian Serie A rivals Gremio.
- Souza began his career at Fluminense in 2003 and also had spells at Benfica, Flamengo and Metalist Kharkiv, among other clubs.
- He was capped seven times for Brazil's national team and scored two goals.
- Brazilian professional footballer who played as a forward for Vasco da Gama, Grêmio, Sport Recife, and many other clubs.
- In a journeyman career, he played for ten clubs in the Campeonato Brasileiro Série A, including nine of the Big Twelve, having begun at Fluminense in 2003.
- He also played for Sport Recife, where he was Série A top scorer in 2016.
- He earned seven caps for Brazil from his debut in 2009, scoring twice.
