## SJVN partners with IIT Patna to improve tunneling project performance

- SJVN, formerly known as Satluj Jal Vidyut Nigam, has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indian Institute of Technology Patna (IIT Patna) to use advanced geological models in SJVN's tunnelling projects, thus significantly reducing time and cost overruns.
- One of the key outcomes of this partnership will be the development of predictive analytics algorithms. These algorithms, leveraging integrated geotechnical data, will forecast potential risks and provide early warning systems specifically tailored for tunnelling projects. Such proactive measures are expected to substantially mitigate time and cost overruns during project execution. The collaboration also aims to evaluate the intricate relationship between overburden and deformation, thereby enhancing the evaluation and design of support systems crucial for tunneling projects.

## World's Oldest Man, Juan Vicente Perez Mora From Venezuela Dies At 114

- Venezuelan Juan Vicente Perez Mora, certified in 2022 by Guinness World Records as the oldest man in the world, died at the age of 114.
- Perez was officially confirmed as the oldest man alive on February 4, 2022, when he was 112 years and 253 days old, according to Guinness. A father of 11, as of 2022 he had 41 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and 12 great-great-grandchildren. The farmer known as Tio Vicente was born in the town of El Cobre, in the Andean state of Tachira on May 27, 1909, and was the ninth of 10 children.
- Perez went on to become a sheriff and was responsible for resolving land and family disputes, while still working in agriculture.
- Earlier, Maria Branyas Morera celebrated her 117th birthday and with this, she added her name to the Guinness World Records (GWR) list. Born in 1907, she is now the world's oldest living person who has survived World War I, World War II, the Spanish Flu pandemic, and the COVID-19 pandemic.

## IIT-Kanpur Alumnus Sandeep Jain Steps **FISME Presidency**

- Sandeep Jain, an alumnus of IIT-Kanpur and an autocomponent manufacturer, has been elected as President of the Federation of Indian Micro and Small & Medium Enterprises (FISME) for the term 2024-25.
- His appointment was unanimously approved during a meeting of the Central Executive Committee held in New Delhi, marking a significant transition from his prior role as the Vice President of FISME.
- The organization conducts annual elections to elect one third of its Central Executive Committee members, who then choose the President for the upcoming year.
- Jain succeeds Prashant Patel, a manufacturer of Dyes and Chemicals with operations in Ahmedabad and Surat.
- With a background in Mechanical Engineering from IIT Kanpur, Jain commenced his career at TVS Electronics & Tata Unisys before establishing the SOLO Group in Gurgaon back in 1991. SOLO Group, a fully integrated CNC Machine shop, operates from 3 plants housing 52 CNC machines and employs 150 individuals.

## NASA names firms to develop rover for first crewed Moon mission since 1972

- NASA has awarded contracts to three companies to develop vehicles for the first crewed missions to the Moon in more than five decades.
- Intuitive Machines, Lunar Outpost and Venturi Astrolab based in Texas, Colorado and California, respectively were chosen to create designs for the lunar rover under a contract worth up to \$4.6bn.
- NASA plans to pick one of the companies to carry out a test run for their Lunar Terrain Vehicle before the arrival of the crew for the Artemis 5 mission scheduled for 2029.
- The Artemis missions, named after the sister of Apollo in Greek mythology, aim to return humans to the Moon for the first time since Apollo 17 in 1972.
- Under the programme, NASA plans to establish the first long-term presence on the Moon and lay the groundwork for future missions to Mars.
- Artemis 3, the first crewed mission, is scheduled to land in 2026.

- After a long process of two years the GI tag vide certificate number 585 was issued on March 30, 2024.
