

## approves Sub scheme for PM Matsya Samridhi - Yojana

- The Union Cabinet has approved Pradhan Mantri Matsya Kisan Samridhi Sah-Yojana, a Central Sector sub-scheme under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada for the fisheries sector.
- A total of 6000 crore rupees have been earmarked for the scheme over the next 4 years.
- 3,000 crore rupees will come from public finance including the World Bank and the AFD external financing, and the remaining 50 percent will be contributed by the beneficiaries from the private sector.
- The scheme will help to gradually formalize the fisheries sector and enhance access to institutional credit.
- This initiative will support 6.4 lakh micro-enterprises and 5,500 fisheries cooperatives, providing access to institutional credit.
- This sub-scheme will help to create a National Fisheries Digital Platform to provide 40 lakh small and micro-enterprises work-based identities.
- The scheme will be implemented for 4 years from FY 2023-24 to FY 2026-27 across all the States and UTs.
- The Cabinet has also approved the extension of the Fisheries Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) for another 3 years up to 2025-26. The government approved the fund size of 7522.48 crore rupees and budgetary support of 939.48 crore rupees. To address the infrastructure requirement for the fisheries sector, the Government during 2018-19 created the Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) with a total funds size of 7522.48 crore rupees.

CCEA approves six projects of Ministry of Railways with total estimated cost of Rs 12,343 crore

- Cabinet Committee **Affairs** on Economic (CCEA)approved six projects of the Ministry of Railways with a total estimated cost of 12,343 crore rupees.
- The six projects will be 100 per cent funded by the Central Government.
- The multi-tracking proposals will ease operations and reduce congestion which will provide the much-required infrastructural development on the busiest sections across Indian Railways.
- The 6 (Six) projects covering 18 Districts in 6 States, which include, Rajasthan, Assam, Telangana, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Nagaland
- It will increase the existing network of Indian Railways by 1020 Kms and will provide employment of about three crores man-days to the people of the States.
- These projects are the result of PM-Gati Shakti National Master Plan for multi-model connectivity, which has been possible through integrated planning and will provide seamless connectivity for the movement of people, goods and services.

- Union Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister Arjun Munda launched LMS, Krishi Rakshak Portal and helpline and SARTHI initiative under Prime Minister Fasal Bima Yojana, PMFBY in New Delhi.
- These initiatives insured farmers will be benefitted and their risk will be also reduced.
- The Krishi Rakshak Portal and Helpline is an integrated grievance redressal mechanism having a digital portal and a call centre has been developed to enable farmers to lodge their grievances, concerns and queries.
- The innovative SARTHI (Sandbox for Agricultural and Rural Security, Technology and Insurance) platform harnesses technology to provide a broad spectrum of insurance products, offering coverage for health, life, property, agriculture tools, motor assets and disaster risks.
- The Learning Management System (LMS) is designed revolutionize the training and knowledge-sharing landscape for stakeholders in implementing key agricultural schemes across the country. Ministers of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Shobha Karandlaje and Kailash Chaudhary were also present at the event.

Parliament passes two Constitution Order Amendment Bills to modify SC and ST lists in Andhra Pradesh and **Odisha** 

- Parliament has passed the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order (Amendment) Bill, 2024 and the Constitution (Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Orders (Amendment) Bill, 2024. The Upper House has already cleared it.
- The Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order (Amendment) Bill, 2024 is intended to amend the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950 to modify the list of Scheduled Tribes regarding Andhra Pradesh to include Bondo Porja, Khond Porja and Konda Savaras communities in the list of ST.
- While the Constitution (Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Orders (Amendment) Bill, 2024 proposes to amend the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950 and the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950 to modify the list of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in relation to Odisha.
- Under it, four communities of primitive tribes Pauri Bhuyan, Chuktia Bhunjia, Bondo and Mankidia and 46 others who have not been included in the ST list due to phonetic variations or spelling mistakes will be the part of ST list.
- The Government is committed to the protection of tribal and the upliftment of the poor. He hit out at the Congress for not taking steps to bring these tribes to the ST list. The Government has come out with the PM-JANMAN scheme, with a budgetary allocation of 24 thousand crore rupees for the tribal community.

# BIMSTEC aquatic championship: India leading the tally with 36 medals including 13 Gold

- At the first-ever edition of the ongoing BIMSTEC aquatic championship in Delhi, India is leading the tally so far with 36 medals including 13 Gold, 17 Silver, and 6 Bronze.
- The hosts had 18 medals at the end of Day one and added another 18 medals to their tally earlier.
- Thailand with 27 medals is in the second spot and Sri Lanka is third with six bronze medals.
- The tournament is being held across three disciplines swimming, water polo, and diving.
- The BIMSTEC Aquatic Championship is being held from 5-10 February, as an initiative to foster regional cooperation spirit in the Bay of Bengal Region.














## Another NASA-SpaceX backed US firm to launch Moon mission on 14 Feb

- NASA backed private US company Intuitive Machines aims to launch a lander on SpaceX's Falcon 9 rocket on February 14.
- This comes after another NASA-backed company Astrobiotic Technology's lunar lander, last month, suffered "critical" fuel loss and could not make it on the Moon.
- Houston-based Intuitive IM-1 lunar lander is scheduled to lift off atop a Falcon 9 rocket from Florida's Cape Canaveral Space Force Station on Feb. 14 at 12:57 a.m. EST, sending Intuitive Machines' robotic Nova-C lander "Odysseus".
- Odysseus will try to make history, becoming the first-ever private spacecraft to land softly on the lunar surface on February 22.
- The US has not attempted a moon landing since Apollo 17 in December 1972.
- The IM-1 mission will be the Company's first attempted lunar landing as part of NASA's Commercial Lunar Payload Services ("CLPS") initiative, a key part of NASA's Artemis lunar exploration efforts.
- The science and technology payloads sent to the Moon's surface as part of CLPS intend to lay the foundation for human missions and a sustainable human presence on the lunar surface.



Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that former Prime Minister PV Narasimha Rao, as well as Chaudhary Charan Singh and agricultural scientist Dr. MS Swaminathanwill be conferred the Bharat Ratna.

#### Chaudhary Charan Singh: 'Dedicated his life to welfare of farmers'

- Chaudhary Charan Singh served as the sixth Prime Minister of India.
- He was sworn in on July 28, 1979, and was compelled to step down just 170 days later after failing to prove his government's majority on the floor of Parliament.
- After exiting the Congress in Uttar Pradesh in the 1950s, he went on to form the first non-Congress government in the northern state.
- He also went on to form the Bharatiya Kranti Dal (BKD), which later merged with the Samyukta (United) Socialist Party to form the Bharatiya Lok Dal (BLD).
- The BLD emerged as a crucial component of the Morarji Desai-led Janata Party government that came to power in 1977.

#### Former PM Narasimha Rao: 'Fostered a new era of economic development'

- Pamulaparti Venkata Narasimha Rao served as the 10th Prime Minister of India from June 21, 1991, to May 16, 1996, for a total of 1,791 days.
- He is best known for ushering the country into an era of economic reforms.
- Rao previously served as a minister in the Andhra Pradesh government and held a number of portfolios including law, education and health until 1971, when he took over as the Chief Minister. He remained the CM till 1973.

### MS Swaminathan: 'Visionary leadership transformed Indian agriculture'

- Known as the 'Father of the Green Revolution', Dr Swaminathan played a major role in the set of changes introduced in farming in the 1960s and '70s that helped India achieve food security.
