INTERNATIONAL

1) One Ocean summit

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has addressed the high-level segment of the One Ocean Summit. The high-level segment of the summit will also be addressed by several other heads of states and governments including Germany, the United Kingdom, South Korea, Japan and Canada. The One Ocean summit is organised by France.

2) TomTom Traffic Index Ranking 2021

As per TomTom Traffic Index Ranking 2021, Mumbai has been ranked at 5th, Bengaluru at 10th in terms of the most congested cities in the world in 2021. Istanbul, Turkey has been declared as the most congested city in the world as per the ranking.

NATIONAL

1) India-United States Bilateral Trade

Bilateral trade in goods between the two countries crossed the \$100 billion mark in 2021. This is the largest volume of goods trade in a calendar year in India-US economic history. India exports goods worth over \$73 billion and imports over \$40 billion dollars' worth goods, thus retaining a trade surplus.

2) National Career Service

Ministry of Labour and Employment is implementing NCS Project for transformation of National Employment Service. Launched in 2015, it provides a variety of employment related services like job matching, career counselling, vocational guidance etc. All services available in portal are free of cost for all stake holders.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) State Bank of India

The State Bank of India has announced a partnership with NSE Academy to launch five online courses that promote financial literacy as a necessary life skill. The courses curated by SBI are a good blend of theory and operational aspects which will enable learners to have a deeper understanding of the fundamentals of banking, compliance, lending norms and a host of other topics.

1) Munishwar Nath Bhandari

Justice Munishwar Nath Bhandari has been appointed Chief Justice of the Madras High Court. Justice Bhandari had taken over as the Acting Chief Justice of the Madras High Court after the transfer of Justice Sanjib Banerjee to the Meghalaya High Court in November last year.

IMPORTANT DAYS

1) National Deworming Day

National Deworming Day is observed on February 10, to make people aware of the importance of deworming, particularly for children from 1 to 19 years of age, who are the most vulnerable. The Day was launched by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare in 2015.

2) World Unani Day

World Unani Day is observed on February 11th every year to mark the birth anniversary of "Hakim Ajmal Khan", an eminent Indian Unani physician. The first Unani Day was celebrated in 2017 at the Central Research Institute of Unani Medicine, Hyderabad. It was introduced in India by the Arabs and Persians.

3) International Day of Women and Girls in Science

International Day of Women and Girls in Science is observed globally on 11 February. The 7th International Day of Women and Girls in Science Assembly, taking place on 11 February 2022, aims to recognize the role of women and girls in science. The 2022 theme of the Day is "Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion: Water Unites Us".
