INTERNATIONAL

1) “Vivatech 2020”

- “Vivatech 2020”, Europe’s biggest startup conference, has recognized India as the “country of the year.”
- It is a tremendous honour for India to be named “country of the year” in Vivatech 2020.
- This is due to the contribution of the Indian startups to the world. This is the recognition of Indian startups.

2) The Global Livability Index 2022

- The Global Livability Index 2022 is released by the Economics Intelligence Unit.
- The Austrian capital Vienna ranked 1st in the Index, followed by the Copenhagen, and Switzerland's Zurich.
- The Index ranked 140 cities for their urban quality of life based on assessments of their stability, healthcare, culture, environment, education and infrastructure.

NATIONAL

1) Hydro and solar power

- Delhi Airport or Indira Gandhi International Airport has become the first airport in the country to run entirely on hydro and solar power from this month in a major step toward achieving the ambitious goal of becoming a Net Zero Carbon Emission Airport by 2030.
- Delhi International Airport Limited, a GMR Infrastructure Limited-led consortium, which manages and operates the Delhi Airport.

2) “BRO Cafes”

- The Border Roads Organization will build 75 outlets along various route segments in 12 states and union territories under the name “BRO Cafes,” as permitted by the Ministry of Defense.

- Piyush Goyal, Union Minister of Commerce and Industry, inaugurated a "Mango Festival" in Brussels, Belgium to raise awareness among Europeans and establish a market for Indian mangoes in Europe.

1) 17th 'Shala Praveshotsav'

- In Gujarat, the Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel has launched the 17th 'Shala Praveshotsav', the drive to enrol students in primary schools in the state.
- The three-day enrollment drive begins from Memadpur primary school in Vadgam taluka of Banaskantha district.

2) Ambubachi Mela

- Ambubachi Mela, a four day annual fair had begun at Kamakhya Temple in Guwahati, Assam.
- It is celebrated to mark the annual menstruation of Goddess Kamakhya (reigning deity). It also marks as an occasion to promote awareness about menstrual hygiene.

3) Mo Bus

- Odisha's Mo Bus has been recognised by the United Nations for its annual Public Service Awards for 2022.
- Bus service of Odisha's Capital Region Urban Transport (CRUT) authority.
- An e-rickshaw system called 'Mo E-Ride' has been introduced as a last-mile feeder service.
