1) 'Nobel Prize of computing'

- Geoffrey Hinton, the man who won the 'Nobel Prize of computing' for his work on neural networks and is known as the godfather of AI, is now speaking against the dangers of artificial intelligence.
- Hinton, alongside two other so-called godfathers of AI bagged the Turing Award in 2018 for their trailblazing work in artificial intelligence, recently quit his job at Google.

2) Australian High Commission in India

- The Australian High Commission in India has recently announced its government grant for a project in Kargil.
- This is a first-time initiative in the history of Ladakh, and it is expected to provide immense benefits to the region.
- The announcement was made during a special meeting at Srinagar, which was chaired by the Australian high commissioner to India, Barry O'Farrell.

1) Central Board of Secondary Education

2) "Irretrievable breakdown of marriage"

- The Supreme Court of India has granted couples the right to divorce on the grounds of "irretrievable breakdown of marriage" under Article 142 of the Constitution.

3) HDFC Bank Smart Saathi

- The platform aims to take banking products and services to the last mile, and contribute to the development of the country.

4) Reporters Without Borders

- According to the latest report from global media watchdog Reporters Without Borders (RSF), India has slipped to the 161st position out of 180 countries in the 2023 World Press Freedom Index.

- The report was released by RSF, and it indicates a decline in India's ranking for press freedom.

- Nordic countries like Norway, Ireland, and Denmark ranked top three respectively while Vietnam, China, and North Korea were the bottom three countries on the index.

5) World Economic Forum

- A new study by the World Economic Forum (WEF) suggests that the Indian job market is expected to witness a 22% churn over the next five years, with top emerging roles coming from AI, machine learning, and data segments.

- Globally, the job market churn is estimated at 23%, with 69 million new jobs expected to be created and 83 million eliminated by 2027.

IMPORTANT DAYS

1) World Press Freedom Day

- Every year on May 3, we observe World Press Freedom Day to increase understanding about the significance of a press that is free and not influenced by external forces.

- The occasion emphasizes the importance of unrestricted journalism and advocates for the fundamental right of freedom of speech.

- This year's World Press Freedom Day focuses on the theme of "Shaping a Future of Rights: Freedom of Expression as a Driver for All Other Human Rights," which emphasizes the critical role of freedom of expression in safeguarding and promoting other human rights.

2) World Asthma Day

- World Asthma Day is a yearly event that takes place on the first Tuesday of May. Its aim is to increase awareness and encourage better management and care of asthma on a global scale.

- The day is coordinated by the Global Initiative for Asthma (GINA) in partnership with healthcare providers, patient groups, and public health agencies. In 2023, World Asthma Day observed on May 2.

- The Global Initiative for Asthma has designated "Asthma Care for All" as the theme for the 2023 World Asthma Day.
