### Haridwar Kumbh Mela

- The Centre has written to the Uttarakhand government about the need for stringent measures to control the spread of Covid-19 during the ongoing Kumbh Mela at Haridwar.
- Kumbh Mela comes under UNESCO's Representative List of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

## STATE AFFAIRS

#### Right to Health

- CM of Rajasthan announced the implementation of the Rajasthan Model of Public Health that would include a Right to Health as well as measures for preventive, primary and curative care as envisioned by the WHO.
- The Mukhya Mantri Chiranjeevi Yojana will also be launched as a Universal Health Care scheme.

## **Mission Gramodaya**

Shivraj Singh Chouhan, CM of Madhya Pradesh and Narendra Singh Tomar, Union Minister, Ministry of Agriculture jointly launched the Mission Gramodaya for the development of villages in MP.

• It's objective is to provide basic and fundamental infrastructure to rural areas in the state.

#### "Bihar Day"

- **Bihar** is celebrating its 109<sup>th</sup> foundation day on March 22. On this day, Bihar was carved out of the Bengal by the British government in the year 1912.
- Official languages of the state are Hindi and Urdu.

- The **Danish Red Cross** has launched first of its kind catastrophe bond for the volcano-related disasters.
- This bond which will enable the disaster relief agency to get the financial aid quickly to those who are suffering because of the eruption of volcanoes. The project's partners aim to raise \$3 million with the launch of this bond.

## BUSINESS & ECONOMY

### RBI Reported 9.1% Growth in India's Software Services **Export**

RBI released the data related to the 2019-20 round of annual survey on exports of computer software and information technology-enabled services in which India's export of software services stood at US\$ 128.6 billion during 2019-20, registering 9.1 % growth over the previous year.

#### Arogya Sanjeevani Policy

Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India, has hiked the maximum cover under the standard health insurance plan - Arogya Sanjeevani Policy - from Rs 5 lakh to Rs 10 lakh and also has expanded the sum insured bands under the policy to between ₹50,000 and ₹10 lakh in multiples of ₹50,000.

#### 'India Trend Book 2021'

- According to a report 'India Trend Book 2021' released by Ernst Young-Indian Private Equity & Venture Capital Association, India's e-commerce market is expected to be worth USD 99 Billion by 2024.
- Grocery & Fashion/apparel will be the key drivers of this growth.
