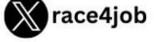

Asian Surfing Championships 2024: India clinch silver medal at Maruhaba Cup

India won a silver medal at the Maruhaba Cup, a team event, at the Asian Surfing Championships 2024 at Thulusdhoo, Maldives.

Final Outcome:

- Gold: Japan with a score of 58.40.
- Silver: India with a score of 24.13.
- Bronze: Taipei with a score of 23.93.
- Fourth Place: China with a score of 22.10.
- Semi-final Performance: The Indian team, comprising Kamali P, Ajeesh Ali, Srikanth D, and Sanjay Selvamani, secured first place in the Heat 2 semi-final with a score of 32.16.

Historical Context:

India secured this medal a day after earning its first-ever quota in surfing for the Asian Games 2026, to be held in Aichi-Nagoya, Japan. Both Indian men's and women's teams will compete in the event.

Individual Achievement:

- Harish Muthu became the first Indian to qualify for the quarter-finals at the Asian Surfing Championships.

Badminton: Tanvi Patri clinches girls' U-15 Singles title at Asia Championships

India's top junior badminton player, Tanvi Patri, clinched the U-15 girl's singles title at the Asia Under-17 & Under-15 junior championships in Chengdu, China.

- U-15 Girls' Singles: Tanvi Patri from India clinched the title.
- Tanvi defeated Nguyen Thi Thu Huygen Vietnam in the final.
- Remarkably, Tanvi, aged 13, won the title without dropping a single game.

Former Lebanese PM Salim al-Hoss dies at 94

• Five-time former Lebanese Prime Minister Salim Hoss, who served during some of the most tumultuous years of his country's modern history, died at age 94.

Political Roles:

- Served as Prime Minister during Lebanon's civil war (1975-1990) and later from 1998 to 2000.
- Former government minister and member of parliament.
- Significance: Described as the "conscience of Lebanon" by Caretaker Prime Minister Najib Mikati.

Historical Context:

- At one point, he led one of two rival governments in Lebanon, with Michel Naim Aoun leading the other.

REC inks pact with JNPA for financing projects up to Rs 45,000 crore

■ Rural Electrification Corporation (REC) Limited signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Authority (JNPA) to finance various upcoming projects. As part of the MoU, REC will provide funds of up to Rs 45,000 crore for JNPA's infrastructure projects, including the development of the Vadhavan port.

Key Points:

- Purpose: To finance infrastructure projects, including the development of the Vadhavan port.
- REC's Role: A public sector non-banking financial company (NBFC) and infrastructure financing company (IFC), providing loans for infrastructure development.

Golf: Keegan Bradley wins his second BMW Championship title

 American professional golfer Keegan Bradley maintained his composure during the final round to clinch victory in the BMW Championship at Castle Pines.

SBI's Dinesh Khara era ends, his successor CS Setty has new challenges

- Dinesh Kumar Khara, the current Chairman of State Bank of India (SBI), will step down after a successful tenure that began on October 7, 2020.
- Khara's leadership period witnessed a significant turnaround in SBI's financial performance, with the bank's net profit from FY21 to FY24 amounting to ₹1.63 trillion, surpassing the combined profit of ₹1.45 trillion achieved over the previous 64 years.
- Historical Context of SBI: SBI traces its roots to the establishment of the Bank of Calcutta in June 1806, later evolving into its current form in July 1955.
- Predecessor's Contributions: Khara's predecessor, Rajnish Kumar, focused on cleaning up SBI's balance sheet, which was burdened with bad loans, leading to losses of ₹15,010 crore in three consecutive quarters. This groundwork set the stage for Khara to navigate the bank through challenging times, including the Covid-19 pandemic.
- Khara's Strategic Response to Covid-19: During the pandemic, Khara implemented innovative financial strategies, such as dollar-rupee swaps, to manage excess deposits and support overseas operations, ensuring the bank's resilience and stability during the crisis.
- Future Challenges for New Chairman: CS Setty, the newly appointed Chairman, will face the challenge of sustaining the momentum achieved under Khara's leadership while addressing emerging issues in the banking sector.














Union Government Announces Creation of **Five New Districts in Ladakh**

Armand Duplantis Sets New World Record at Silesia Diamond League

- Olympic champion Armand Duplantis set a new world record in pole vaulting with a height of 6.26 meters at the Silesia Diamond League's Kamila Skolimowska Memorial.
- Previous Record: Duplantis had previously set a world record of 6.25 meters at the Paris Olympics, where he also defended his Olympic title just 20 days earlier.
- Event Details: The record-breaking performance took place at the Silesian Stadium in Chorzow, Poland. Duplantis achieved the new record on his second attempt after initially failing on his first attempt.
- Significance: This achievement marks Duplantis's 10th world record, further establishing his reputation as one of the greatest pole vaulters in history.

Additional Records:

- Jakob Ingebrigtsen set a new world record in the men's 3,000-meter race with a time of 7:17.55, surpassing Daniel Komen's 1996 record of 7:20.67. Ethiopia's Berihu Aregawi won silver with 7:21.28, and Yomif Kejelcha won bronze with 7:28.44.
