Union Minister H.D. Kumaraswamy Launches PM E-DRIVE Scheme

- Union Minister for Heavy Industries, H.D. Kumaraswamy, launched the PM E-DRIVE Scheme in New Delhi. The scheme aims to promote the adoption of electric vehicles (EVs) across India, encouraging domestic innovation and reducing carbon emissions.
- The scheme has a financial outlay of ₹10,900 crore over a two-year period.
- ₹3,680 crore has been allocated for e-two-wheelers, e-three-wheelers, e-ambulances, e-trucks, and other emerging electric vehicles.
- ₹500 crore is earmarked for the deployment of e-ambulances.
- ₹4,391 crore will be used for the procurement of 14,000 e-buses.
- ₹2,000 crore has been allocated for the installation of fast chargers across the country.
- The scheme will also introduce Aadhar-authenticated e-vouchers for buyers to claim demand incentives, providing a streamlined experience for consumers and manufacturers.

Parth Mane Secures Double Gold at ISSF Junior World Championship in Peru

- Indian shooter Parth Rakesh Mane achieved a remarkable feat by securing double gold in the 10m air rifle event at the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) Junior World Championship in Lima, Peru:
- Parth won the 10m air rifle individual title with a score of 250.7 in the 24-shot final, narrowly defeating reigning junior Asian champion Huang Liwanlin of China by 0.7 points.
- Following his individual success, Parth teamed up with Ajay Malik and Abhinav Shaw to win gold in the 10m air rifle men's team event.
- India secured a third gold medal on the same day when Gautami Bhanot, Sambhavi Kshirsagar, and Anoushka Thakur won the junior women's 10m air rifle team event.
- Ajay Malik and Abhinav Shaw, while performing commendably, finished fifth and seventh in the individual event, with Ajay scoring 186.7 after a shoot-off and Abhinav scoring 144.2.
- With five gold medals to date, India continues to lead the overall medal tally at the championship.

India and Jamaica Exchange 4 MoUs on Digital Infrastructure, Cultural Exchange, and Sports

- India and Jamaica signed four Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) in the areas of Digital Public Infrastructure, Cultural Exchange, and Sports during delegation-level talks held between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Prime Minister of Jamaica, Dr. Andrew Holness, in New Delhi.

Highlights:

- This is the first bilateral visit by the Jamaican Prime Minister to India.
- Prime Minister Modi emphasized the historical ties, democratic values, and strong people-to-people connections between India and Jamaica.
- India is committed to sharing its expertise in Digital Public Infrastructure, small-scale industries, biofuels, innovation, health, education, and agriculture with Jamaica.
- India will assist in training and capacity building for the Jamaican Army in the field of defence.
- Both nations pledged to combat organized crime, drug trafficking, and terrorism.
- India and Jamaica share the view that reforms are necessary in global institutions, including the United Nations Security Council (UNSC), to promote global peace and stability.

ICC Bans Sri Lanka's Praveen Jayawickrama for Breaching Anti-Corruption Code

- The International Cricket Council (ICC) has imposed a one-year ban on Sri Lankan cricketer Praveen Jayawickrama for violating the ICC Anti-Corruption Code. The 26-year-old left-arm spinner admitted to obstructing or delaying an investigation by the ICC's Anti-Corruption Unit (ACU). His violations included concealing, tampering with, or destroying information relevant to the investigation.
- Jayawickrama, 26, made his debut for Sri Lanka across all formats in 2021. In his debut Test against Bangladesh in Pallekele, he was named Player of the Match for taking an 11-wicket match haul.
- He has taken 25 wickets in five Test matches, five wickets in as many ODIs, and two wickets in five T20Is. A slow left-arm spinner, Praveen last played in the Major Clubs Limited Over Tournament, a domestic 50-over competition in Sri Lanka. He has not participated in international cricket for Sri Lanka since a T20I series against Australia in Pallekele in June 2022.

Highlights:

- Jayawickrama has accepted the one-year sanction, with the last six months suspended.
- The ban applies to all forms of cricket.

ISSF Junior World Championship: Divanshi Wins Gold in Women's 25m Pistol for India

- ISSF Junior World Championship in Lima, Peru, India secured five additional gold medals, bringing the total to 14 medals in the championship, including 10 gold, one silver, and three bronze.
- Divanshi won a gold medal in the women's 25m pistol, defeating Italy's Cristina Magnani by two points with a final score of 35. Heloise Fourre from France secured the bronze medal.
- Divanshi achieved a double gold by teaming up with Tejaswini and Vibhuti Bhatia to win the junior women's 25m pistol team gold, finishing ahead of teams from Czech Republic and Germany.
- Mukesh Nelavalli emerged as another standout, winning two gold medals, increasing his total to three in the championship. He claimed gold in the junior men's 25m pistol with a score of 585, finishing two points ahead of fellow Indian Suraj Sharma, who won the silver medal. In the team event, Mukesh, Suraj, and Pradhyumn Singh secured gold, narrowly defeating Poland by three points.

PM MODI UNVEILS RS.83,000 CR TRIBAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN JHARKHAND

PM Modi Launches Rs 83,000 Crore Tribal Development Schemes

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated a series of development projects worth over Rs 83,000 crore from Hazaribagh, Jharkhand, aimed at tribal upliftment. The central initiative, "Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan," worth Rs 79,156 crore, targets economic empowerment of around 5 crore tribals across 63,000 villages in 2,740 blocks of 549 districts in 30 states and Union Territories.

Key features of the scheme include:

- Construction of 20 lakh houses for tribal families
- Development of 25,000 km of rural roads and bridges
- Provision of clean drinking water, gas, and electricity connections to all households
- Establishment of 100 tribal market centres, mobile health centres, ashrams, and skill development centres
- Additionally, PM Modi launched the PM Jan Man Yojana, inaugurated 40 Eklavya Model Residential Schools, and laid the foundation stone for 25 more schools in Jharkhand. These schools aim to provide quality education to tribal children in remote areas.

India's Khushi Wins Bronze at ISSF Junior World Championship 2024

- Indian shooter Khushi secured a bronze medal in the women's 50m rifle 3 positions (3P) event at the ISSF Junior World Championship held in Lima, Peru. This victory brought India's total medal tally to 15 medals—comprising 10 gold, 1 silver, and 4 bronze—with India maintaining the top position in the medal standings.
- Khushi scored 447.3 in the final, finishing behind Caroline Lund (silver) and Synnoeve Berg (gold), both from Norway. Khushi had placed seventh in the qualification round with a score of 585, narrowly securing a spot in the final. She managed to climb to third place in the final, overcoming a wobble in the later shots to claim the bronze.
- In the junior women's 3P team event, the Indian team, consisting of Sakshi Padekar, Melvina Joel Gladson, and Prachi Gaekwad, finished in fifth place with a total score of 1757.

Alcaraz Sets New Record With China Open Win Over Sinner

- Carlos Alcaraz won his first China Open title in 2024 by defeating top seed Jannik Sinner.
- The match lasted three hours and 21 minutes, with Alcaraz winning with a score of 6-7(6), 6-4, 7-6(3).
- This victory gave Alcaraz his 16th ATP tour singles title and made him the second Spaniard, after Rafael Nadal, to win the China Open men's singles title.
- The win also ended Jannik Sinner's unbeaten streak in Beijing.
- Alcaraz credited his team for helping him regain focus after a challenging phase following the American swing.
- In the women's singles, Zheng Qinwen, the Paris Olympic champion, advanced to the quarterfinals by defeating Amanda Anisimova of the United States.
- The 2024 China Open is a professional tennis tournament played on outdoor hardcourts. It is the 23rd edition of the China Open for the men and the 25th for the women.

- The Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, has attained affiliate membership in the International Medical Device Regulators Forum (IMDRF).
- **IMDRF Overview:** The IMDRF is a global network of medical device regulators aimed at promoting regulatory convergence and enhancing public health and safety.
- **Membership Application:** The CDSCO applied for IMDRF membership in August 2024 to align its medical device regulatory system with global standards.
