- India's Tejaswin Shankar clinched victory in the men's High Jump event at the USATF Festival in Tucson, Arizona, USA.
- The National record holder Tejaswin cleared 2.23 metres in his first attempt to secure the top spot at the World Athletics Continental Tour Silver event.
- With this jump, he equaled his season-best effort.
- Earnie Sears of USA finished second, while Roberto Vilches of Mexico was third.
- Another Indian athlete, Sarvesh Kushare cleared 2.13m to finish fifth.

## REC receives RBI approval to set up subsidiary in **Gujarat's GIFT City**

- State-owned REC Ltd has received RBI's approval to set up a subsidiary in GIFT City, Gujarat.
- The proposed subsidiary will engage in a range of financial activities as a finance company within GIFT, including lending, investment, and other financial services.
- According to the statement, REC Ltd, under the Ministry of Power and a leading NBFC, has received a No Objection Certificate' (NOC) from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) for setting up a subsidiary in Gujarat International Finance Tech-City (GIFT) in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- The decision to expand operations into GIFT, burgeoning hub for financial services in India, comes as REC continues to diversify its portfolio and explore new avenues for growth.

#### startup Mindgrove unveils Indian 1st indigenous high-performance chip

- As India begins its chip-making journey, fabless semiconductor startup Mindgrove Technologies, said that it has launched the country's first commercial, highperformance SoC (system on chip).
- 'Secure IoT,' the RISC-V Called (open-source architecture)-based chip will help domestic original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) use a homegrown chip in their devices.
- The IIT Madras-incubated startup said that the chip is likely to cost 30 per cent less than other chips in the same segment.
- Mindgrove designed and sent out the chip for manufacturing within eight months, which is faster than industry standards of two to three years.
- The chip is a high-performance microcontroller clocked at 700 MHz.
- It can control devices from smartwatches to smart city devices like connected electricity, water, and gas metres — to connected home devices and even EV battery management systems.
- The country consumes over a billion chips a year and anywhere between 10 to 50 million of them can be replaced by 'Secure IoT'.

## Actor Bernard Hill, of 'Titanic' and 'Lord of the Rings,' dies at 79

- Actor Bernard Hill, who delivered a rousing cry before leading his people into battle in The Lord of the Rings: The Return of the King" and went down with the ship as the captain in Titanic, has died.
- Hill joined The Lord Of The Rings franchise in the second film of the trilogy, 2002's The Two Towers, as Thoden, King of Rohan. The following year, he reprised the role in Return of the King, a movie that won 11 Oscars.
- In one of the film's most memorable scenes, Hill's character fires up his overmatched forces by delivering a battle cry on horseback that sends his troops thundering downhill toward the enemy and his own imminent death.
- He was nominated for an award in 1983 from the British Academy of Film and Television Arts for the role, and the show won the BAFTA for best drama series.

## South Korea to take part in US-led cyber exercise amid rising security threats from North Korea

- South Korea's Cyber Operations Command will participate in a U.S.-led multinational cyber exercise to strengthen its capabilities to counter malicious cyber activities.
- 9 personnel from the South's military will join the Cyber Flag exercise to be held in the U.S.
- The online exercise is designed to hone skills for multinational cooperation in countering share intelligence and cyberthreats against enemies' cyber activities.
- Since 2011, the U.S. Cyber Command has conducted the cyber exercise annually to enhance the readiness of Washington, its allies and partner countries against security threats in the online domain.
- This year's exercise involves 18 nations, including "Five Eyes" intelligence alliance, which consists of the U.S., Britain, Australia, Canada and New Zealand, and other partner countries.

## India, Ghana agree to operationalise UPI link within 6 months

- India and Ghana are working to link their payment systems - Unified Payments Interface (UPI) and Ghana Interbank Payment and Settlement Systems (GHIPSS) respectively to permit users to make instant, low-cost fund transfers on a reciprocal basis.
- The two countries have also delved into discussions regarding the possibilities of a Memorandum of Understanding on Digital transformation Solutions; Local Currency Settlement System and opportunities offered by African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA).
- India's UPI has already reached countries including Singapore and the UAE.
- Talks are also on with Nigeria for the same.
- NPCI International has recently announced partnership with Bank of Namibia to support them in developing a UPI-like real-time payment system in the African nation.
- Note: The bilateral trade between India and the West African nation Ghana has increased to USD 2.87 billion in 2022-23 from USD 2.6 billion in 2021-22.

#### Norris takes first F1 win in Miami GP

- McLaren's Lando Norris took advantage of a midrace Safety Car period to beat Max Verstappen and win his first Formula One Grand Prix in Miami.
- Norris had been running sixth in the early stages of the race, but everything changed when the Safety Car was deployed on lap 29 after Kevin Magnussen tangled with Logan Sargeant at Turn 3, sending both into the barriers.
- McLaren had brought upgrades to Miami, and Norris had shown genuine pace on his way to victory, crossing the line 7.6 seconds ahead of the previously dominant Verstappen.
- Behind the top two, Ferrari's Charles Leclerc rounded out the top three, with teammate Carlos Sainz fourth after overtaking Norris' teammate Oscar Piastri, who subsequently needed to pit for a new front wing, ruining his chances of points.
- Verstappen's teammate Sergio Perez had a lowkey run to fifth place, ahead of Mercedes' Lewis Hamilton in sixth.

## Bengaluru's Flying Wedge Defence Unveils India's First Indigenous Bomber UAV

- Defence and aerospace company Flying Wedge unveiled its bomber UAV - FWD-200B - which it said would advance India's unmanned air combat prowess with costefficiency and indigenous capabilities.
- The Bengaluru-based company said the UAV would address India's need for an advanced unmanned combat aircraft and boost efforts toward self-reliance in a segment critical to modern warfare.
- Flying Wedge had, in 2023, secured a DGCA type certification for its indigenous UAV technology.
- FWD-200B is a MALE (medium altitude, long endurance) UAV with a fuel capacity of 100 kg.
- It comes with optical surveillance payloads and integrated with missile-like weapons for precision air strikes.
- The UAV has a maximum speed of 370 kmph (200 knots), an endurance capacity of 12 to 20 hours, and a ground control station range of 200 km.
- At six metres long, with an eight-metre wingspan, the aircraft can carry a maximum take-off weight of 498 kg and has an operational altitude of 9,000 ft above mean sea level.
