#### INTERNATIONAL

## 1) Global Hunger Index 2021

- India's rank has dropped to the 101st position among 116 countries in the Global Hunger Index 2021.
- In 2020, India was placed at 94th spot, out of 107 countries. The 2021 GHI score of India is recorded at 27.5 out of 50, which comes under the serious category.
- The index is published jointly by Welthungerhilfe and Concern Worldwide.

### 2) Lake Sawa

- Recently, Irag's "pearl of the south" Lake Sawa has run dry amid water crisis that experts say is induced by climate change, including record low rainfall and back-toback drought.
- It was formed over limestone rock and studded with gypsum formations and has no inlet or outlet.

### **NATIONAL**

# 1) Australia-India water security initiative

- The cabinet approved a Memorandum of Understanding between India (Ministry) of Housing and Urban Affairs) and Australia for Technical Cooperation for AIWASI.
- AlWIS was launched in 2020 at the 4th World Water Summit in New Delhi where Australian announced \$10 million to support cooperation between Australia and India on urban water security.

## 2) Russia becomes India's second biggest oil supplier

- Russia has overtaken Saudi Arabia to become India's second-biggest supplier (for May 2022) of oil behind Iraq.
- After U.S. and China, India is the world's third-largest consumer of oil, over 80% of which is imported.

## 1) OmniCard

- OmniCard has became the 1st RBI licensed PPI (prepaid payment instrument) to launch cash withdrawal using a RuPay-powered card from any ATMs across the country.
- The move came in after RBI permitted the non-bank licensed entities to enable cash withdrawals from the digital wallets.

### **SPORTS**

### 1) Khelo India Youth Games (KIYG) 2021

- Haryana won the Khelo India Youth Games 2021 title with 52 gold medals. Haryana also won 39 silver and 46 bronze medals, taking their overall medal tally to 137 medals.
- Maharashtra, meanwhile, managed 45 gold, 40 silver and 40 bronze medals to come second with 125 medals.
- Karnataka, with 22 gold, 17 silver and 28 bronze, finished third with 67 medals.
