INTERNATIONAL

1) Stockholm+50

- Stockholm+50 is an international meeting convened by the United Nations General Assembly in Stockholm, Sweden.
- It commemorates 50 years since the 1972 UN Conference on Human Environment, which made the environment a pressing global issue for the first time.
- In 1968, Sweden first proposed the idea of the Stockholm conference.
- Theme: Stockholm+50: A healthy planet for prosperity of all - our responsibility, our opportunity.

NATIONAL

1) Scheme for Residential Education for Students in High Schools in Targeted Areas

- SHRESTHA provides level playing field and high quality free residential education to poor and meritorious Scheduled Caste students from class 9th to class 12th.
- It's objective is to fill the gap in service-deprived SC dominant areas in the sector of education by collaborating with voluntary organizations.

- The campaign was started on the initiative of District Collector Ankit Kumar Singh to ensure all necessary medical aid to pregnant women at the pre and post-natal stage so that maternal and infant mortality rates could be reduced.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Infrastructure Investment Trust

- InvIT, a hybrid between equity and debt investment, is a business trust (like REIT), registered with the market regulator, that owns, operates, and manages operational infrastructure assets.
- In India, InvITs (Infrastructure Investment Trust) are regulated by SEBI.

2) Overseas Direct Investment

- Savvy investors are using ODI route to bet on cryptocurrencies abroad with liberalised remittance facility (LRS).
- ODI is an investment made outside India in a Joint Venture or Wholly Owned Subsidiary either under Automatic Route or Approval Route.
