




NP Singh to step down as MD & CEO of Sony Pictures Networks India

- NP Singh, managing director and chief executive officer of Sony Pictures Networks India (SPNI), will step down from his post once the company finds a suitable replacement.
- A long-time Sony employee, Singh had joined the company in June 1999 as its chief financial officer and was subsequently elevated to the position of COO in 2004 and MD and CEO in 2014.
- On 22 January, Sony Group Corp., the Japanese parent company of Sony Pictures Networks India (SPNI), which is now called Culver Entertainment, and Bangla Entertainment Pvt. Ltd (BEPL), had announced the termination of the \$10-billion merger agreement with Zee Entertainment Enterprises.

India only country among world's top 5 to register rise in steel production

- India is the only country among the world's top steel producing nations to post a growth in steel production during April this year, according to figures compiled by the World Steel Association.
- India, the second-largest steel producer in the world next to China produced 12.1 million tonnes of steel which represented a 3.6 per cent increase.
- According to economists, the growth in India's steel production reflects the higher level of economic activity taking place in the economy.
- The World Steel Association data show that Japan produced 7.1 million tonnes (MT) of steel, down 2.5 per cent.
- The US produced 6.7 MT, down 2.8 per cent.
- Russia is estimated to have produced 6.2 MT, down 5.7 per cent and South Korea produced 5.1 MT, down 10.4 per cent.
- China, which has massive excess capacity in steel and has run into the US tariff barrier for its exports, recorded a 7 per cent decline production to 85.9 million tonnes.

IMF approves \$164.6 mn funding for Rwanda

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) announced the approval of 164.6 million U.S. dollars in funding for Rwanda to strengthen its economic resilience against future climate shocks.
- The package includes 76.2 million dollars from the Resilience and Sustainability Facility (RSF) and 88.4 million dollars through the Standby Credit Facility
- The policy mix should prioritize macroeconomic and financial stability, fiscal sustainability, and the restoration of buffers.
- Maintaining the strong reform momentum under the RSF will help bolster the country's economic resilience to future climate shocks.
- Rwanda's real gross domestic product growth exceeded expectations in 2023, reaching 8.2 percent.
- Key drivers of this growth included the services sector, construction, and recovery in food crop production despite severe floods.
- The IMF recommended that the Rwandan government adopt a carefully planned fiscal strategy to mitigate the impact of last year's deadly floods, ensuring sustained economic stability and growth.

World Para-Athletics Championships 2024: Five World Records Broken in a Single Day as China Win Six Medals

- Five world records were broken at the Para Athletics World Championships, the seventh day of the event which also saw Chinese athletes claim six medals and set two Asian records.
- The men's 400m T12 final saw Turkish runner Serkan Yildirim, 32, smash the world record by clocking 47.47 seconds, as New Zealand's Danielle Aitchison, 22, set the women's 200m T36 record in 27.47s at the Universiade Memorial Stadium in the central Japanese port city of Kobe.
- Algeria's 31-year-old Skander Djamil Athmani broke the men's 400m T13 world record in 46.44s, while his compatriot, 41-year-old Safia Djelal, shattered her own world record of women's shot put F57 with a throw of 11.62 meters.
- In the women's shot put F64 final, France's Alexandra Nouchet, 26, though ranking fourth, smashed the world record of her own category F63 with a throw of 10.64m.
- The Kobe 2024 Para Athletics World Championships, held in East Asia for the first time, serve as a crucial qualifier for the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games.
- Chinese athletes swept six gold medals breaking two Asian records on the tracks at the Universiade Memorial Stadium, China's para runners celebrated triple one-two victories.

What Is the Cost to Apply for a UAE Golden Visa?

- The costs of a 5 year and 10 years UAE golden visa are AED 650 and AED 1,150 (approx.) respectively.




Air India appoints Sanjay Sharma as CFO with effect from June 10

- Air India has announced the appointment of Sanjay Sharma as the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) with effect from June 10.
- Sharma will succeed Vinod Hejmadi, who is retiring after more than three decades with Air India.
- He was the CFO at Tata Projects Ltd. Earlier, he has served as the CFO at Tata Realty Infrastructure Ltd, and Managing Director, Head of Equity Capital Markets, at Deutsche Bank Group, among other roles.
- Note: Tata Group took control of loss-making Air India from the government in January 2022.

Jio Financial Services plans \$4.33 billion deal with Reliance Retail

- Jio Financial Services (JFS) is seeking shareholder approval for its unit to acquire equipment worth Rs 36,000 crore (\$4.33 billion) from the retail arm of Reliance Industries as the financial services provider plans to enter the device leasing business.
- Under the proposed deal, the JFS unit called Jio Leasing Services will buy telecom equipment and devices that usually include routers and cell phones.
- Jio Leasing Services will rent out the equipment it buys to customers of Reliance Jio Infocomm -Reliance's telecommunications arm.
- This company will compete in the device-rental market with the likes of Hewlett Packard and Lenovo.

- Bengaluru-based Biocon has announced exclusive licensing and supply agreement with Handok to commercialise the South Korean company's obesity drug Synthetic Liraglutide in that country.
- Liraglutide, which is administered via a pre-filled pen injection, is used for chronic weight or obesity management alongside a reduced-calorie diet and increased physical activity. Biocon will handle the drug's development, manufacturing and supply, while Handok will manage regulatory approval and commercialisation in the South Korean market.
- Handok provides comprehensive solutions from diagnosis to treatment and care.
- Its diabetic portfolio features products such as Amaryl and Tenelia, along with the recently launched Barozen Fit, a real-time glucose monitoring device.
