INTERNATIONAL

1) CAE's artificial intelligence

- AirAsia India becomes the first airline to use CAE's artificial intelligence-powered training system to train the airline's pilots.

NATIONAL

1) AK-630 guns

- Indian Navy received the first-ever completely made-in-India 30mm ammunition. The ammunition will be used in AK-630 guns, which is fitted on warships.
- Economic Explosives Ltd. from Nagpur supplied the 100 per cent indigenous 30mm gun ammunition to the Indian Navy.

2) 'Samajik Adhikari Shivir'

- 'Samajik Adhikari Shivir' was organized in Nagpur for the distribution of aid and assisting devices to Senior Citizens under 'Rashtriya Vayoshri Yojana' and 'Divyangjan' of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.
- Shri Nitin Gadkari inaugurated the Campaign and distributed different kinds of aids and assisting devices to Divyangjan and Senior Citizens.

3) National Cancer Grid

1) Bank of Baroda launched a Yoddha

- Bank of Baroda launched a Yoddha co-branded RuPay credit card for Indian Army troops by Bank of Baroda-backed BOB Financial Solutions in collaboration with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI).
- The new co-branded credit card will be made available on the RuPay platform and have contactless characteristics.

APPOINTMENTS AND RESIGNATIONS

1) Justice Uday Umesh Lalit

- Justice Uday Umesh Lalit took oath as the 49th Chief Justice of India.
- President of India Smt Droupadi Murmu administered the oath of office at a ceremony held at Rashtrapati Bhavan.
- Justice Lalit is one of the six senior counsels who have been directly elevated to the Supreme Court.
- He will retire on 8 November 2022 after assuming the office of Chief Justice of India for a period of seventy-four days as the 49th chief justice.

2) Sourav Ganguly

AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS

1) UNESCO Felix Houphouet-Boigny Peace Prize 2022

- Former German Chancellor Angela Merkel has won UNESCO Felix Houphouet-Boigny Peace Prize 2022 for her 'efforts to welcome refugees'.
- This prize was established in 1989. It is awarded to those who have made a significant contribution to promoting, seeking, safeguarding or maintaining peace.

SPORTS

1) FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup 2022

- The Bureau of the FIFA Council has decided to lift the suspension that was imposed on the All India Football Federation (AIFF) due to undue third-party influence.
- The FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup 2022 will be held in India as planned. The FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup will now be successfully held in the country in October.

2) World Judo Cadet (U18) Championships

- Linthoi Chanambam (India) scripted history by winning India's first-ever medal in Judo World Championships with a gold in the Women's 57kg category at the World Judo Cadet Championships. The 15-year-old judoka defeated Brazil's Bianca Reis in the 57-kg category final.
- Linthoi Chanambam became the first Indian judoka to win a medal at any age-group category of the World Championships.
