




Legendary actor Mithun Chakraborty to be honoured with Dada Saheb Phalke award

Veteran actor Mithun Chakraborty, 74, will be honoured with the prestigious Dadasaheb Phalke award, the government's highest recognition in field of cinema, for his remarkable contributions to Indian cinema at the 70th National Film Awards ceremony at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi.

Winners from the 70th National Film Awards include:

- Best feature film: Aattam (The Play), a Malayalam film, won the award for its innovative narrative structure and character depth.
- Best actor: Rishab Shetty won the award for his performance in the Kannada film Kantara.
- Best director: Sooraj Barjatya won the award for Uunchai.
- Best actress: Nithya Menen and Manasi Parekh shared the award.
- Best debut film of a director: Fouja, a Haryanvi film, won the award.
- Best actor in a supporting role: Fouja won the award.
- Best lyrics: Fouja won the award.

ISSF Junior World Championship: Indian pair clinche Bronze in Shooting

- In Shooting, the Indian pair of Gautami Bhanot and Ajay Malik clinched Bronze after defeating Croatia in the Air Rifle mixed event in the ISSF Junior World Championship in Lima, Peru. In the same event, China defeated France to win gold.
- In the Air Pistol mixed event, India's Lakshita and Pramod defeated Kanishka Dagar and Mukesh Nellavani 16-8 to win another Bronze in the tally.
- Germany won the gold medal, while Ukraine settled for a silver.
- With this, India retained its top spot in the ISSF Junior World Championship.

India's Overall Performance:

India retained the top spot with a total of five medals (2 Gold, 3 Bronze) in the championship.






BCCI Inaugurates National Cricket Academy (NCA) as Centre of Excellence (CoE) in Bengaluru

The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) inaugurated the newly upgraded National Cricket Academy (NCA) in Bengaluru, now called the BCCI Centre of Excellence (CoE).

Facility Details:

- Spanning 40 acres, the Centre includes three world-class grounds and 86 pitches (indoor and outdoor).
- There are 45 outdoor net pitches for practice, with safety nets sourced from the UK.
- The indoor facility has 8 premium pitches with turfs from the UK and Australia.
- Advanced facilities include a Sports Science Medicine Centre, which will also support Indian Olympians and athletes from various sports disciplines.
- Additional amenities include jacuzzi, physiotherapy rehab gym, and sports science lab with modern technology.
- Objective: The Centre aims to advance sports science and contribute to the overall growth of the Indian sports ecosystem, extending support beyond cricket to athletes across disciplines.

Gulveer Singh wins gold medal in men's 5,000 meters race at World Athletics Continental Tour

• Gulveer Singh, a 26-year-old Indian athlete, won the gold medal in the men's 5,000 meters race at the World Athletics Continental Tour in Japan.

New National Record:

- Time: 13 minutes 11.82 seconds
- Broke his own previous record of 13 minutes 18.92 seconds set earlier this year
- Previous record holder: Avinash Sable

Other Achievements:

- In March 2024, Gulveer Singh broke the national record in the Men's 10,000 meters at the Ten Track Meet in California with a time of 27 minutes 41.81 seconds, surpassing Surender Singh's 2008 record of 28 minutes 02.89 seconds.
- Olympic Qualification: Missed the Paris Olympics 2024 qualification time of 27:00.00 by over 41 seconds.

Indra Sena Reddy Becomes Mizoram Governor; Justice Manmohan Sworn in as Delhi HC Chief

- Indra Sena Reddy Nallu, Governor of Tripura was sworn in to take additional charge as the Governor of Mizoram.
- Position: Governor of Tripura, now holding additional charge as Governor of Mizoram.
- Reason for appointment: Taking charge during the absence of the incumbent Governor, Dr. Hari Babu Kambhampati.
- Oath of office: Administered by Justice Nelson Sailo, Judge, Gauhati High Court.

Political career:

- Three-time legislator in undivided Andhra Pradesh (1983, 1985, 1999).
- BJP state president in 2003.
- National general secretary of BJP in 2014.
- On the other hand Justice Manmohan took oath as the Chief Justice of Delhi High Court.
- New Position: Chief Justice of Delhi High Court.
- Appointment notification: Issued by the Central Government on September 21.
- Previous role: Acting Chief Justice of Delhi High Court.
- Supreme Court Collegium recommendation: Appointment recommended on July 11.
- Retirement date: Scheduled for December 16.

Re-Election of Arun Dhumal and Avishek Dalmiya to IPL Governing Council: Key **Points**

- Arun Singh Dhumal and Avishek Dalmiya re-elected as members of the IPL Governing Council during the BCCI's 93rd Annual General Meeting (AGM) Bengaluru.
- Continuation of Roles: Dhumal will continue as IPL chairman for another year, which is crucial given the upcoming mega auction.
- Player Representation: V Chamundeswaranath, former Andhra and South Zone cricketer, nominated by the Indian Cricketers Association (ICA) as a representative, was inducted into the IPL Governing Council.
- Approval of Auction Recommendations: The AGM approved IPL Governing Council's recommendations for the player auction cycle 2025-2027, including player retention and salary cap regulations.

Retention Rules for IPL 2025:

- Franchises can retain a total of six players from their existing squads.
- Deadline for retention decisions is October 31.
- Retention can be through direct retention or the Right to Match (RTM) option.

NASA's Europa Clipper Set for Launch; **SpaceX Crew 9 to Rescue ISS Astronauts**

- NASA's Europa Clipper mission, scheduled for journey to Jupiter and its moon Europa, is nearly ready to go on October 10.
- Mission Objective: Journey to Jupiter and its moon Europa, with a focus on exploring Europa's potential to support life.
- Launch Date: Scheduled for October 10, 2024.
- Launch Vehicle: SpaceX's Falcon Heavy rocket from NASA Kennedy's Launch Complex 39A.
- Scientific Focus: Europa has a salty ocean beneath its icy crust, which may contain the building blocks for life.
- **Distance to Travel:** The spacecraft will travel 2.6 billion kilometers to reach Jupiter's system.
- Arrival Date: Expected to reach Jupiter in April 2030.
- Gravity Assists: These will be used to increase the spacecraft's momentum for reaching Jupiter.
- Mission Plan: Orbit Jupiter and conduct around 50 flybys of Europa.
- Goal: To determine if Europa has environments below its icy surface that could support life.
