INTERNATIONAL

1) Indian and Malaysian bodies sign deal to support palm oil business

- The Malaysian Palm Oil Council and the Indian Vegetable Oil Producers' Association have signed a memorandum of understanding to expand their cooperation in promoting the usage of palm oil.
- The MoU is anticipated to increase collaboration in areas of shared interest and to advance the production and consumption of palm oil from Malaysia and palm oil with the MSPO certification.

NATIONAL

1) 'India International Bullion Exchange (IIBX)'

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched the 'India International Bullion Exchange (IIBX)', at the Gujarat International Finance Tec-City near Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- IIBX is India's first international bullion exchange. Ashok Gautam will head IIBX as MD and CEO.

2) Innovative and first Teaching Robot in India

- Indus International School has launched the innovative and first Teaching Robot in India, the Eagle Robot.
- Three of the Indus Schools have 21 Eagle Robots deployed, with seven in each of Hyderabad, Bangalore, and Pune. Eagle Robot is very interactive, personalises the experience, and emulates emotions through the digital face.

3) Index of eight Core Industries

- As per Ministry of Commerce & Industry, the Index of eight Core Industries increased by 12% in June 2022 against 9.4% in June 2021.
- ICI measures combined and individual performance of production in selected eight core industries viz. Petroleum Refinery Products (28.04%); Electricity (19.85%); Steel(17.92%), Coal (10.33%), Crude Oil (8.98%), Natural Gas (6.88%), Cement (5.37%), Fertilizers (2.63%).

STATE NEWS

1) Punjab Khed Mela

- The Punjab Sports Department will host the Punjab Khed Mela, which will feature 30 sporting activities in six age divisions for competitors between the ages of 14 and 60.
- The event's goals are to find talent, create a welcoming environment for sports, and raise public awareness of health.

2) "Mukhyamantri Mahtari Nyay Rath"

- The Chhattisgarh Women Commission will host the Mukhyamantri Mahtari Nyay Rath Yatra. On the occasion of the Hareli Tihaar festival, Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel will set off the "Mukhyamantri Mahtari Nyay Rath".

3) Loktak lake

- Manipur government to remove all floating houses and fishing structures on Loktak lake.
- Loktak lake is the largest freshwater lake in Northeast India. It is also called as 'floating lake' for numerous phumdis or masses of vegetation it supports.
- Keibul Lamjao is the only floating national park in world floats over it.

IMPORTANT DAYS

1) International Friendship Day

- International Friendship Day is celebrated annually on July 30 and it was first proposed way back in the year 1958 by World Friendship Crusade, an international civil organisation.
- In India as well as many other countries, Friendship Day is also celebrated on the first Sunday of August.

2) World Day Against Trafficking

- World Day Against Trafficking is observed annually on 30 July to make people aware of who is being trafficked. Theme of 2022: "Use and abuse of technology".

3) World Ranger Day

- World Ranger Day is observed on 31st July every year. The International Ranger Federation established this day to honour the contribution of Park Rangers to the preservation of nature.
- The day is also an opportunity to pay tribute to rangers who have lost their lives in the line of duty.

4) World Hepatitis Day

- World Hepatitis Day, observed every year on July 28, to create awareness of viral hepatitis. Hepatitis means inflammation of the liver.
- Theme of "Bringing hepatitis care closer to you".

SPORTS

1) Birmingham Commonwealth Games 2022

- Indian weightlifter, Gururaja Poojary has won a bronze medal in the men's 61kg final at the Birmingham Commonwealth Games 2022.
- Poojary successfully pulled off a combined lift of 269kg, (118kg in snatch and 151kg in clean and jerk) to ensure India's second medal of the Games.
