India's new rocket SSLV-D3 lifts off with earth observation satellite (EOS-08)

- India's new rocket Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV-D3) lifted off with an earth observation satellite-08 (EOS-08) weighing 175.5 kg.
- Piggyback Satellite: Chennai-based start-up Space Rickshaw's small satellite SR-0 also launched on this mission.

Key Technology:

- SSLV has a payload capacity of 500 kg to Low Earth Orbit (LEO).
- Developed by ISRO to meet the global market trend for smaller satellites.
- Rocket Specifications:
- SSLV is 34 meters tall and weighs about 119 tons.
- The cost of the rocket is approximately Rs 56 crore.

Mission Objective:

- Complete the SSLV Development Project.
- Enable operational missions by Indian industry and public sector organization NewSpace India Ltd. (NSIL).

- If elected, Paetongtarn Shinawatra will become Thailand's second woman Prime Minister.
- She will also be the third member of the Shinawatra family to hold this position, following her father, Thaksin Shinawatra, and her aunt, Yingluck Shinawatra.
- Former Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin was removed from office by a Constitutional Court ruling over an ethical violation.
- The court found him guilty of appointing a Cabinet member involved in an alleged bribery case.

ADB approves \$30 mn grant to improve healthcare services in Tajikistan

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has sanctioned a \$30 million grant aimed at enhancing healthcare services in Tajikistan.
- In a recent gazette notification, the state government appointment of Anand Mahindra, announced the chairperson of Mahindra and Mahindra Group, as the chairman of the Board of Governors of Young India Skill University. Additionally, Srinivas C Raju, a noted industrialist and educationalist, has been appointed as a member of the board and designated as co-chairman.
- According to the gazette, Anand Mahindra and Srinivas C Raju will serve as chairman and co-chairman of the university, respectively, for a term of one year. This follows the enactment of the Young India Skills University, Telangana (Public-Private Partnership) Act, 2024, which came into effect on August 14. The Act outlines the need for these appointments to guide the university's development and operations.

ADB:

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) is a regional development bank based in Manila, Philippines, established in 1966. It has 68 member countries and focuses on reducing poverty and promoting economic growth in Asia and the Pacific. The ADB provides loans, technical assistance, and grants for various development projects, including infrastructure and healthcare.

- Lukuvi has been appointed Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office for policy, parliament, and coordination, replacing Mhagama.

Additional Adjustments:

- Pindi Chana has been reassigned from the Ministry of Constitutional and Legal Affairs to the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism.
- Angellah Kairuki, former Minister of Natural Resources and Tourism, has been appointed as a presidential adviser.

Telangana govt appoints Anand Mahindra as Skill university chairman

- The state government has issued a gazette notification, confirming the appointment of Anand Mahindra, chairperson of Mahindra and Mahindra Group, as the chairman of the Board of Governors of Young India Skill University.
- The government also appointed Srinivas C Raju, better known as Srini Raju, a prominent industrialist and educationalist, as a member of the board who is designated to act as co-chairman of the university.
- As per the gazette notification, Anand Mahindra and Srini Raju would serve as chairman and co-chairman of the varsity, respectively, for a period of one year.
- The state government has enacted the Young India Skills University, Telangana (Public-Private Partnership) Act, 2024, which officially came into force on August 14.
- Under the provisions of the Act, the state government deemed it necessary to appoint a chairperson members of the Board of Governors to lead the University.
