

Nobel Prize in Chemistry 2024: David Baker, Demis Hassabis, and John Jumper awarded for protein innovations

The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences announced the winners of the 2024 Nobel Prize in Chemistry.

Laureates:

David Baker (University of Washington, Seattle, USA) received one half of the prize for his work in "computational protein design."

Demis Hassabis and John M. Jumper (Google DeepMind, London, UK) shared the other half for their contributions to "protein structure prediction."

Breakthroughs:

Protein Design: David Baker's focuses work on designing proteins with specific structures and functions.

Protein Structure Prediction: Demis Hassabis and John M. Jumper's achievement involves predicting protein structures from amino acid sequences, a long-standing challenge in biology.

Scientific Impact: These discoveries construction of new proteins and fulfill a 50-year-old goal of accurately predicting protein structures, opening up new possibilities in the field of protein science.

- First Awarded: In 1901 to Jacobus Henricus van 't Hoff.
- Laureates: Awarded 115 times to 193 individuals as of 2023.














Repo rate remains unchanged at 6.50% for tenth time in a row

Repo Rate Unchanged at 6.50%:

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI), during the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting held on October 7-9, 2024, decided to maintain the repo rate at 6.50% for the tenth consecutive time. Since February 2023, the RBI has maintained the status quo on this key policy rate.

Other Rates:

The Standing Deposit Facility (SDF) rate remains at 6.25%, while the Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate and Bank Rate are unchanged at 6.75%.

Monetary Policy Stance:

The MPC has shifted its stance to a neutral position, emphasizing a clear focus on aligning inflation with the medium-term target while also supporting economic growth. The goal is to achieve the Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation target of 4% ($\pm 2\%$).

Economic Growth:

- India's real Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth for the first quarter of FY 2024-25 stood at 6.7%, driven by private consumption and investment.

Sri Lanka cabinet approves agreement to facilitate trade with Russia

The Sri Lankan cabinet has approved an agreement aimed at facilitating legally valid trade activities with Russia through transparent and predictable customs procedures. This agreement seeks to formalize trade cooperation between the two nations, ensuring smoother trade relations.

Timeline of Approval:

Although the initial cabinet approval for this bilateral trade agreement was granted on November 15, 2021, after several rounds of discussions between Sri Lanka and Russia, the agreement had not yet been signed. The latest cabinet approval, presented by President Anura Kumara Dissanayake, who also holds portfolios in finance, economic development, policy formulation, and tourism, seeks to officially finalize this trade pact.

Trade Relationship History:

- Trade between Sri Lanka and Russia has witnessed significant growth since the disintegration of the Soviet Union in 1991. However, despite Sri Lanka maintaining a favorable trade balance between 2007 and 2014, a gradual rise in imports and a decline in tea exports since 2015 have caused fluctuations in the trade balance.














Justice Manoj Kumar Tiwari appointed **Acting Chief Justice of Uttarakhand HC**

- The Central government has approved the appointment of Justice Manoj Kumar Tiwari as the acting Chief Justice of the Uttarakhand High Court.
- Transition: Justice Tiwari will assume the role of acting Chief Justice upon the retirement of the current Chief Justice, Ritu Bahri, on October 10.
- Supreme Court Collegium's Recommendation: September 24, the Supreme Court Collegium recommended Justice Narendar G for the position of Chief Justice of the Uttarakhand High Court.
- Current Position of Justice Narendar G: Justice Narendar G is presently serving as a judge in the Andhra Pradesh High Court.
- **Pending Approval:** The Central government has not yet cleared the Collegium's recommendation for Justice Narendar G's appointment as Chief Justice.
- The Chief Justice of a High Court in India is appointed following a process that involves several constitutional authorities and steps. Here is a summary of the procedure:




Romania to enhance air defense by acquiring US Sentinel radar systems

- Romania plans to enhance its air defense capabilities by acquiring four AN/MPQ-64 F1 Sentinel radar systems.
- Procurement Method: The acquisition is being made through the U.S. Foreign Military Sales program.
- Deployment Purpose: The radar systems will be deployed within Romania's ground-based air defense battalions to improve airspace monitoring and counter modern aerial threats, especially from unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs).

South Korea, Singapore sign supply chain partnership arrangement

- South Korea and Singapore agreed to strengthen cooperation in various sectors across supply chains, energy, bio and advanced technology.
- Cooperation Agreement: South Korea and Singapore have agreed to strengthen cooperation in various sectors, including supply chains, energy, bio, and advanced technology.
- Supply Chain Partnership: The agreement is based on a supply chain partnership arrangement signed during South Korean President Yoon's three-day state visit to Singapore.
- Significance: This marks the first supply chain deal between the two nations and follows a multilateral agreement signed by 14 members of the Indo-Pacific Economic Framework, initiated by the U.S. in May 2022.

- Crisis Response Network: The network will facilitate emergency meetings between the two governments within five days of detecting supply chain disruptions.
- Extradition Treaty: An extradition treaty was signed to enable the arrest and extradition of fugitives between South Korea and Singapore.
