launches new strategy to **ADB** boost Turkmenistan's economy

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has unveiled a new country partnership strategy for Turkmenistan, covering the period from 2024 to 2028.
- This strategy aims to foster a competitive, diversified, and knowledge-based economy driven by innovation in the private sector.

Key Focus Areas:

- Green Transformation: ADB will invest in energy efficiency, renewable energy, low-carbon pilot projects, and policy reforms to enhance sustainability.
- Transport Networks: The strategy will sustainable and integrated transport networks, especially railways in key trade corridors within the Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation region.
- Private Sector Development: Efforts will be made to cultivate an export-oriented private sector by expanding access to capital for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs).
- Capital Development: Reforms Human implemented in the health sector to improve access, quality, and services, alongside efforts to enhance skills in the health workforce and promote entrepreneurship.

first woman Iran gets government as spokesperson

- President Masoud Pezeshkian Fatemeh appointed Mohajerani as Iran's new government spokesperson, marking the first time a woman holds this position.
- Mohajerani, with a Doctorate in Business Administration, brings significant experience from previous roles in education and government.
- She joins other high-ranking women like Shina Ansari and Farzaneh Sadeq Malvajard.
- Fatemeh Mohajerani, aged 54 years old, was born in the city of Arak in 1970. She obtained her Doctorate of Business Administration from the Edinburgh Campus of Heriot-Watt University in Scotland.
- During the government of Hassan Rouhani, Mohajerani held the position of head of the Technical and Vocational Training University of Shariati, which is an institution specifically for female students.
- In 2017, she was also chosen to lead the Center for Brilliant Talents.
- Throughout her career, Mohajerani has held various other roles within the Education ministry.
- This is the most recent appointment of a woman to a senior position

Cabinet okays Rs 4,136 crore scheme for hydroelectric projects in northeastern states

- The Union Cabinet has approved funding of ₹4,136 crore to aid northeastern states in developing hydropower projects with a capacity of 15,000 MW over the next eight years.
- This central assistance will cover up to 24% equity stake in joint ventures, with implementation scheduled between FY25-32 under the power ministry's budgetary support.
- The scheme aims to enhance local investment and employment in the region.

Which northeastern states will benefit from this scheme?

- The northeastern states that will benefit from this scheme include Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, and Tripura.
- scheme aims to support the development of hydropower projects with a total capacity of 15,000 MW across these states by 2032.
- The central assistance will encourage participation by state governments and minimize delays due to land acquisition and local issues

Union Cabinet decides to of expand scope **Agriculture Infrastructure Fund scheme**

The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has taken a significant step to enhance India's agricultural sector by approving the expansion of the Agricultural Infrastructure Fund (AIF) scheme.

Here are the key highlights of this expansion:

- Farming Assets: The AIF now Viable infrastructure development for community farming assets, allowing eligible beneficiaries to enhance community farming capabilities.
- Integrated Processing Projects: Eligible activities under the AIF now cover both primary and secondary processing projects. However, standalone secondary projects remain under the Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) schemes.
- PM KUSUM Component-A Integration: The AIF and Component-A of the PM-KUSUM scheme can now converge. This integration promotes sustainable clean energy solutions alongside agricultural infrastructure development.
- Enhanced Credit Guarantee Coverage: The AIF credit guarantee coverage has been extended to Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) through the NABSanrakshan Trustee Company Pvt. Ltd. This aims to improve financial security and encourage investments in agricultural infrastructure projects.



Nuclear India's **Submarine** 2nd Missile Commissioned by Rajnath Singh

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh is set to commission India's second nuclear-powered ballistic missile submarine (SSBN), INS Arighat (S-3), during a discreet event in Visakhapatnam.
- The 6,000-tonne INS Arighat is expected to soon undertake a long-range patrol in the Indo-Pacific region, equipped with K-15 nuclear ballistic missiles that have a range of 750 km.
- This addition marks a significant boost to India's strategic nuclear capabilities, joining the already active INS Arihant (S-2) in patrolling the high seas.
- INS Arighat (S-3) is India's second nuclear-powered ballistic missile submarine (SSBN), a crucial asset in the country's strategic defense capabilities.
- The submarine is part of India's effort to establish a credible and effective nuclear deterrent, specifically contributing to its nuclear triad, which includes landaircraft-delivered based missiles, weapons, and submarine-launched ballistic missiles.
