

Moody's Ratings raises India's GDP growth forecast to 7.2 percent for fiscal year 2024

- Moody's Ratings, a New York-based global rating agency, has revised its real GDP growth forecast for India to 7.2 percent for the fiscal year 2024, up from the previous estimate of 6.8 percent.
- agency has also updated its growth projections for FY 2025 to 6.6 percent, an increase from the earlier estimate of 6.4 percent.
- The upward revision is attributed to strong, broadbased growth, particularly driven by resilient consumption and improved business private conditions.
- India's economy recorded a 7.8 percent year-overyear growth in Q1 2024, despite challenges such as tight monetary policy and fiscal consolidation efforts.
- The industrial and services sectors are performing well, with the Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) remaining above 60 since the start of the year.
- Moody's report also highlighted the strengthening capital expenditure (capex) cycle, supported by rising capacity utilization and ongoing government infrastructure spending.

India Makes First Payment for Hybrid Power Projects in Sri Lanka

- India has made the first payment for hybrid power projects located in the northern part of Sri Lanka.
- The payment was handed over by the High Commissioner of India to Sri Lanka, Santosh Jha, to Dr. Sulakshana Jayawardena, Secretary of the Ministry of Power and Energy, and Mr. Ranjith Sepala, Chairman of the Sri Lanka Sustainable Energy Authority.
- The projects are situated on the Delft, Nainativu, and Analaitivu islands and are being executed by an Indian entity under a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between India and Sri Lanka in March 2022.
- These projects are funded by a USD 11 million grant from India, aiming to meet the energy needs of the islands through solar and wind power.
- Initial work has commenced at the project sites, with completion expected by March 2025 and handover by April 2025.
- The initiative is set to strengthen the energy partnership between India and Sri Lanka.

Former Jharkhand CM Champai Soren Resigns from Ministerial Post

- Champai Soren, former Chief Minister of Jharkhand, has resigned from his position as a Minister in the Hemant Soren government and from all posts within the Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM).
- In his resignation letter to JMM President Shibu Soren, he cited dissatisfaction with the party's working style and policies as the reason for his departure.
- Champai Soren held portfolios in the Water Resources Department and Higher Education and Technical Education.
- He has also resigned as the MLA for the Seraikela constituency in the Jharkhand Assembly.
- Champai Soren announced his intention to join the BJP, stating that this decision is in the interest of Jharkhand.
- Champai Soren had taken oath as the 12th Chief Minister of Jharkhand on February 2, but resigned from the post on July 3, a day before Hemant Soren took oath as the 13th Chief Minister on July 4.

Fitch Reaffirms India's Sovereign Debt Rating

- Fitch Ratings has reaffirmed India's sovereign debt rating at 'BBB-' with a stable outlook.
- The global rating agency's decision is based on India's robust medium-term growth prospects and solid external finance position.
- GDP Growth Projections:
- 7.2% for Financial Year 2025
- 6.5% for Financial Year 2026
- Growth is supported by public infrastructure investments, strong private sector investment in real estate, and a resurgence in manufacturing.
- The 'BBB' rating indicates low default risk with adequate capacity to meet financial commitments despite potential vulnerabilities from adverse conditions.



Dhulikhel Declared Nepal's First 'Healthy City' by WHO

- The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared Dhulikhel Municipality in the Kavrepalanchok district as Nepal's first 'healthy city' and the second healthiest city in Asia.
- Dhulikhel achieved this status through various health initiatives implemented since 2014 and has been monitored by WHO since 2021.
- The municipality scored 65.48 points on indicators such as citizens' access to health, participation in health policymaking, political commitment to health, nutrition, and child health.
- Dhulikhel has joined the WHO Healthy City Network and has been awarded USD 5,000 for its efforts under the Healthy City initiative.
- This recognition comes as Nepal faces challenges, being ranked the third most polluted country in the world based on satellite-derived particulate matter 2.5 data.

Bangladesh Wins SAFF U-20 Championship for the First Time

- Bangladesh has won the SAFF U-20 Championship for the first time by defeating Nepal with a score of 4-1 in the final.
- The tournament, organized by the South Asian Football Federation (SAFF), took place from August 18, 2024, and included teams from Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, India, the Maldives, and Bhutan.
- India was the previous champion, having won the SAFF U-20 Championship in 2019, 2022, and 2023.
- The SAFF U-20 Championship is a biennial football tournament for male players under the age of 20.

Paralympics 2024: Avani Lekhara wins gold, Mona Agarwal bronze in women's 10m air rifle standing SH1

- In the Paris 2024 Paralympics, Avani Lekhara and debutant Mona Agarwal initiated India's medal tally with outstanding performances in the women's 10m air rifle standing SH1 event.
- Avani Lekhara, 22, secured the gold medal with a score of 249.7, setting a new Paralympic record and becoming the first Indian woman to win two gold medals at the Paralympic Games.
- She replicated her gold-winning performance from Tokyo 2020, where she had previously set the record.
- Mona Agarwal, competing in her first Paralympic Games, won the bronze medal with a score of 228.7, marking a strong debut for India in the event.

agree to boost Morocco, Senegal transport cooperation

- In a significant move to enhance transport cooperation, of Transport Logistics, Minister Moroccan and Mohammed Abdeljalil, and Senegalese Minister of Transport, Malick Ndiaye, held a meeting in Rabat to focus on deepening ties, particularly in the railway sector.
- The meeting, part of an official visit by the Senegalese delegation to Morocco, resulted in an agreement between the Moroccan National Railways Office and Senegal's National Company for the Management of the Regional Express Train Heritage.
- Additionally, Morocco's Railway Training Institute also signed an agreement with the Senegalese side. Both ministers emphasized the importance of improved communication and collaboration, with Ndiaye praising Morocco's advanced practices in urban and intercity mobility.
- This visit and subsequent agreements mark a significant step forward in strengthening transport cooperation between the two nations.


Renowned seer Raghavacharya passes away

- Raiwasa Peethadheeshwar Renowned seer Raghavacharya, who played a significant role in the Ram Janmabhoomi movement, passed away due to cardiac arrest, casting a pall of gloom not only in Sikar but also among his followers across the country.
- Raghavacharya was the president of the Rajasthan Sanskrit Academy and a gold medalist in both Vedanta and the All India Sanskrit Competition. He established Raiwas Veda Vidyalaya, whose alumni serve in many renowned institutions.
- As the chief priest of the Lord Shri Ram temple, the oldest temple in Sikar constructed in 1570, he believed that the Muslims of Ayodhya supported the construction of the temple.
- His contributions to Sanskrit education and religious discourse have left a lasting impact.
