Centre, Tripura Government, NLFT, and ATTF to Sign Memorandum of Settlement

Key Points:

- Parties Involved: The Government of India, Tripura State Government, National Liberation Front of Tripura (NLFT), and All Tripura Tiger Force (ATTF) will sign a Memorandum of Settlement in New Delhi.

IAF Software Development Institute Bengaluru Deploys Super Dimona Aircraft Simulator for NDA Training

- The Software Development Institute of the Indian Air Force (IAF) in Bengaluru has designed, developed, and deployed a Super Dimona aircraft simulator for the National Defence Academy (NDA).
- Purpose: The simulator is intended to familiarize NDA cadets with basic flying principles and provide essential knowledge of the flying environment, aiding in their training.
- **Technology:** The simulator features a state-of-the-art 135-degree Field of View (FoV) immersive display, enhancing the visual experience for trainee cadets.
- Collaboration: Local private industries were engaged in the mechanical modification, fabrication of flight controls, and installation of display screens and panels, replicating those found in the actual aircraft.














Ajay Ratra Appointed as BCCI Selector

- The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) has appointed former India wicket-keeper Ajay Ratra as a selector for the men's cricket team.
- Replacement: Ratra replaces Salil Ankola in the five-member selection panel.

Panel Structure:

- Regional Representation: All five selectors represent different zones. Ratra will represent the North Zone.
- Panel Head: The panel is headed by Ajit Agarkar.

Previous Situation:

- West Zone: Following Agarkar's appointment as chief selector last year, the panel included two selectors from the West Zone, including Ankola.
- Upcoming Series: This appointment comes ahead of the two-Test series against Bangladesh starting September 19. Ratra will assume his role during the Duleep Trophy.

Defence Ministry Approves 10 Proposals Worth Rs 1.45 Lakh Crore

- The Defence Acquisition Council (DAC), led by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, has approved 10 capital acquisition proposals.
- Total Cost: The proposals amount to Rs 1.45 lakh crore.
- Indigenous Contribution: Local Sourcing: 99% of the total cost is allocated to indigenous sources under the Buy (Indian) and Buy (Indian-Indigenously Designed Developed and Manufactured) categories.

Key Proposals:

- Future Ready Combat Vehicles (FRCVs): Approved for modernizing the tank fleet of the Indian Army. These tanks will feature superior mobility, all-terrain capability, multilayered protections, and real-time situational awareness.
- Air Defence Fire Control Radars: Approved for detecting and tracking aerial targets and providing firing solutions.
- Forward Repair Team (Tracked): Approved for in-situ repairs during mechanized operations, designed and developed by Armoured Vehicles Nigam Limited.

Maharashtra Government Signs MoUs for Rs 2.14 Lakh Crore Investment in Hydro Power Sector

- The Maharashtra government signed MoUs with seven companies for investments totaling Rs 2.14 lakh crore in pumped storage projects.
- Companies: The agreements include NTPC, Welspun New Energy, NHPC, Renew Hydro Power, THDC India, Torrent Power, and Adani Green Energy.
- Power Generation: The projects are expected to generate 40,870 megawatts (MW) of power.

Objective and Benefits:

- **Development Goal:** According to Deputy Chief Minister and Power Minister Devendra Fadnavis, the investment will accelerate Maharashtra's goal of becoming a \$3 trillion economy.
- Sustainable Energy: The projects will focus on sustainable power generation using natural resources.

Company Investments and Impact:

- NTPC: Rs 9,078 crore investment for generating 1,800 MW and creating 1,400 jobs.
- Welspun New Energy: Rs 5,000 crore investment for generating 1,200 MW and creating 1,500 jobs.
- **NHPC:** Rs 44,100 crore investment for generating 7,350 MW and creating 7,350 jobs.

Paris Paralympics: India's Deepthi Jeevanji wins bronze in women's 400m T20 category

- Deepthi Jeevanji won a bronze medal in the women's 400m T20 category at the Paralympics.
- She clocked 55.82 seconds, finishing behind Yuliia Shuliar of Ukraine (55.16 seconds) and Aysel Onder of Turkey (55.23 seconds).

Previous Achievements:

- Deepthi entered the Paris Paralympics as a strong gold contender after setting a world record of 55.07 seconds at the World Para-Athletics Championships in May in Japan.
- She also won the 400m T20 gold at the Hangzhou Asian Games last year with an Asian record of 56.69 seconds.
- Category: The T20 category is for athletes with intellectual impairment.
- Background: Deepthi was born to daily-wage laborer parents in Kalleda village, Warangal district, Telangana.
- Historical Achievement: She became the second Indian to win a medal in a track event at the Paralympics, following Preethi Pal.
- Competition: Yuliia Shuliar, who won the gold, previously won a silver at the Tokyo Paralympics three years ago.

Annual defence drill "Namejs 24" begins in Latvia

- Namejs 24, Latvia's comprehensive national defense exercise, began and will continue until October 8.
- Participants: Involves 11,000 soldiers and National Guard members, including conscripts, reserve soldiers, and allied troops stationed in Latvia.
- Coordination: Organized in cooperation with NATO's Multinational Division North headquarters in Adazi, near Riga.
- Allied Forces: Includes soldiers from the US, Estonia, Lithuania, and NATO's multinational battlegroup, alongside the Mechanised Infantry Brigade of the NAF Land Forces.
- Support: Supported by the UK-led Expeditionary Force and NATO headquarters representatives.
- Activities: Shooting drills will be conducted at military training grounds.

Switzerland reopens embassy in Iraq after 33-year closure

- Switzerland has reopened its embassy in Baghdad, Iraq, after 33 years of closure due to the Gulf War.
- Reason: The Swiss Foreign Ministry cited the improved security situation in Iraq as the primary reason for reopening.
- **Strategic Focus:** This move of part Switzerland's broader strategy to strengthen its presence in the Middle East and North Africa.
- Economic Opportunities: Iraq offers promising long-term export and investment opportunities for Swiss companies, especially in the energy sector.
- Cooperation: Switzerland aims to prioritize cooperation on migration issues with Iraq.
- Consular Services: Consular services and visa inquiries will still be managed by the Swiss embassy in Amman, Jordan.
- Background: Switzerland initially closed its embassy in Iraq following the 1991 Gulf War, which was aimed at expelling Saddam Hussein's forces from Kuwait.

South Korea, New Zealand agree to boost security cooperation

- South Korea and New Zealand agreed to enhance bilateral cooperation in economy, trade, science, and education.
- South Korean President Yoon Suk-yeol and New Zealand Prime Minister Christopher Luxon met for the first time since Luxon's office began in November 2023.
- They will promote bilateral trade and investment under the 2015 free trade agreement (FTA) and establish a regular economic security dialogue.
- Focus will be on advanced science and technology, including fostering a private-sector-led space industry.
- Discussions will be held to strengthen cooperation between national disaster management agencies of both countries.
- Expansion of student scholarship programs and increased exchange of information on regional and international issues were agreed upon.
