INTERNATIONAL

1) India-Tajikistan Friendship Hospital

- Indian envoy handed over the India-Tajikistan Friendship Hospital in Bokhtar to the Tajikistan side.
- Tajikistan is a landlocked Central Asian country sharing its borders with Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan, Afghanistan and China.
- Highest Peak is Qullai Ismoili Somoni.

2) Buddha relics

- India has sent the holy Buddha relics for celebration of the Mongolian Buddh Purnima.
- Mongolia is also known as the "Land of the Eternal Blue Sky" and "Land of the Horse".

3) Microplastics in Antarctic

- Scientists have found Microplastics - plastic pieces smaller than a grain of rice - in freshly fallen Antarctic snow for the first time, which can influence the climate by accelerating melting of ice.
- Previous studies have found that microplastics have negative impacts on the health of the environment, limiting growth, reproduction, and general biological functions in organisms, as well-as negative implications for humans.

NATIONAL

1) Thang Ta

- Recently, in Kashmir, a maulvi stepped in to save thang-ta, a martial law practice.
- Thang Ta is a martial art technique highly prevalent in the state of Manipur.
- Huyen langlon is an Indian martial art from Manipur.

2) Western Zonal Council meet

- The Minister of Home Affairs chaired the 25th meeting of the Western Zonal Council at Diu.
- Zonal Councils are the statutory bodies. They are established by an Act of the Parliament, that is, States Reorganisation Act of 1956.
- The act divided the country into five zones- Northern, Central, Eastern, Western

3) Fossilised dinosaur eggs

- A team of researchers from University of Delhi have discovered a unique set of fossilised dinosaur eggs, with one egg nesting within the other.
- While eggs-within-eggs are a rare phenomenon, they are so far known to occur only in birds and never known in reptiles.

4) India's life expectancy up by 2 years

- As per sample registration system data, India's life expectancy at birth increased to 69.7 years (male 68.4 and female 71.1) in the 2015-19 period (estimated global average is 72.6 years).
- Life expectancy at birth is defined as how long, on average, a newborn can expect to live, if current death rates do not change.

5) National e-Vidhan Application

- NeVA system has been developed to make all the work and data related to legislative bodies available online for the use of both citizens and the members of Assemblies.
- e-Vidhan is re-designated as NeVA. Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs is Nodal Ministry for rolling out NeVA.
- NeVA aims to bring all the legislatures of the country together, in one platform thereby creating a massive data depository.

1) World Day Against Child Labour

- World Day Against Child Labour is observed on June 12th.
- On this day, the ILO, together with its constituents and partners, is calling for increased investment in social protection systems and schemes to establish solid social protection floors and protect children from child labour.
- Theme of 2022: "Universal Social Protection to End Child Labour."
