



Indian Mixed Team Breaks National Record At Asian Athletic Relay Championships 2024

- The Indian Mixed team broke the national record at the ongoing Asian Athletic Relay Championships 2024 Bangkok in Thailand.
- The team comprising Muhammad Ajmal, Jyothika Sri, Amoj Jacob and Subha Venkatesan won gold in the 4x400m event.
- Sri Lanka and Vietnam won silver and bronze in the event.
- The quartet are out of the two spots available for the Paris Olympics via the rankings route at the moment and are in the 21st place in the Road to Paris list of World Athletics while the aim was to be either in the 15th or 16th spot.

Samsung replaces chip chief with veteran exec Jun as SK Hynix takes AI lead

- Samsung Electronics has replaced the chief of its semiconductor division to help the overcome a "chip crisis", amid a booming market for AI chips where analyst say the world's biggest memory chipmaker lags peers.
- The South Korean manufacturer has appointed Young Hyun Jun, effective immediately, moving him from the role as head of its future business planning unit.
- Jun previously led Samsung's memory chip department after working on the development of DRAM and flash memory chips.
- The move is likely aimed at catching up in the market for top-end chips used in artificial intelligence (AI) such as high bandwidth memory (HBM) chips where Samsung has fallen behind rivals such as SK Hynix, analysts said.
- Replacing such a high-ranking position in the middle of the year is unusual, given most personnel changes at Samsung normally take place in the beginning of the year, analysts said.
- Current chip division chief Kye Hyun Kyung will succeed Jun as head of the future business unit.

India, UNDP partner to digitise vaccine cold chain for livestock

- The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying signed a pact with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to digitise the supply chain for livestock vaccines to monitor the cold chain management process.
- The memorandum of understanding (MoU) aims to use technology like artificial intelligence to monitor vaccine storage temperatures and stocks in real-time across India's large network of livestock farms, an official statement said.
- With the digitalisation of the entire vaccine stock management system, the inequities in vaccine supply will be addressed," said Alka Upadhyay, Secretary of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD).

Elon Musk launches Starlink service in Indonesia.

- Elon Musk arrived in Indonesia's resort island of Bali to launch Starlink satellite internet service in the world's largest archipelago nation.
- Musk is slated to launch the service alongside Indonesian President Joko Widodo in a ceremony later at a public health clinic in Denpasar, the provincial capital of Bali.
- Musk will also sign an agreement on enhancing connectivity in the country's health and education sectors.
- He said launching the service at a health clinic aligns with Starlink's broader mission of providing affordable access to high-speed internet services, particularly in underserved and remote regions.
- Indonesia is a vast archipelago of 17,000 islands sprawled across three time zones with a population of more than 270 million.
- During his first in-person visit to Bali, Musk is also scheduled to participate in the 10th World Water Forum, which seeks to address global water and sanitation challenges.














Iga Swiatek wins third Italian Open Title.


