1) National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme

- Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) announced that NAPS will be part of Direct Beneficiary Transfer scheme.
- Now, government will directly transfer its contribution to bank accounts of apprentices through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), 25% of the stipend payable up to Rs. 1500/- per month.
- NAPS launched in 2016.

2) Chakmas

- Recently, National Human Rights Commission seeks report on harassment of Chakmas in Arunachal Pradesh.
- Majority of the Chakma people are Theravada Buddhists.

3) Operation "NARCOS"

- Railway Protection Force recovered narcotics products valued over \$7.40 Crore in a month against narcotics smuggling through rail under code name Operation "NARCOS".

4) Alluri Sitarama Raju

- Prime Minister unveiled Alluri Sitarama Raju's statue in Andhra Pradesh to celebrate 125th birth anniversary.
- He was born at Mogallu village in West Godavari district.
- He is referred to as "Manyam Veerudu". He had led Rampa rebellion, which was launched in 1922.

5) Swachh Sagar, Surakshit Sagar campaign

- Swachh Sagar, Surakshit Sagar Campaign by Ministry of Earth Science to Celebrate International Coastal Clean-up Day.
- It'll be first-of-its-kind and longest running coastal cleanup campaign in world with highest number of people participating in it.
- Globally, "International Coastal Clean Up Day" is celebrated on third Saturday of September, every year.
