INTERNATIONAL

1) South Korea launches its first ever lunar mission

- South Korea launches its first ever lunar mission or it can also be called its first ever mission beyond low Earth orbit.
- The mission was formerly called the Korea Pathfinder Lunar Orbiter (KPLO), which is now known as Danuri, a play on the Korean words for "moon" and "enjoy".
- Danuri was launched from SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket from Cape Canaveral Space Force Station.

NATIONAL

1) Abrogation of Article 370 and 35 A

- Third anniversary of abrogation of Article 370 and 35 A that gave J&K its special status and mandate to define its domicile rules was observed on 5th August.
- In August 2019, President of India promulgated Constitution (Application to Jammu and Kashmir) Order, 2019 which stated that provisions of Indian Constitution were applicable in the State.

2) Exercise Skylight

- The Indian Army reportedly tested the operational readiness of its satellite-based systems deployed across the country under operation 'Skylight'.
- Satellite-based systems provide resilience to communication capabilities in case terrestrial connectivity is disrupted in conflicts.

3) National Water Awards

- Ministry of Jal Shakti has launched 4th National Water Awards on Rashtriya Puraskar portal.
- National Water Awards were introduced to recognize and encourage exemplary work and efforts made by States, Districts, individuals, etc. in accomplishing government's vision 'Jal Samridh Bharat'.

- BPS is an interoperable platform for standardised bill payment experience and has centralised customer grievance redress mechanism.

2) Startup India Seed Fund Scheme

- Startup India Seed Fund Scheme was launched in 2021 by the Ministry of Commerce & Industry.
- It provides financial assistance to eligible Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade recognised startups through eligible incubators for proof of concept, prototype development, product trials, market entry and commercialization.

1) Jagdeep Dhankhar

Jagdeep Dhankhar was elected as the 14th Vice President of India. Jagdeep Dhankhar was the candidate nominated by the NDA from BJP. Jagdeep Dhankhar was serving as the Governor of West Bengal before getting nominated for the Vice President Elections 2022.

- Jagdeep Dhankhar secured 528 votes. The Opposition Margaret Alva received the votes of 208 MPs.
