INTERNATIONAL

1) Global Security Initiative from China

- The Chinese President has proposed a new Global Security Initiative.
- The new Global Security Initiative will work against the Cold War Mentality or hegemonism, power politics and bloc confrontation.
- It will counter the US Indo-Pacific Strategy, Quad (the India, US, Australia and Japan grouping) and AUKUS (Australia, UK and US).

2) UN World Tourism Organization

- Russia has withdrawn from UNWTO amid Ukraine conflict.
- UNWTO is United Nations agency responsible for promotion of responsible, sustainable and universally accessible tourism.
- India is the founder member of UNWTO.
- Headquarters : Madrid, Spain.

NATIONAL

1) Azadi se Antyodaya Tak

- Ministry of Rural Development launched 90 days Azadi se Antyodaya Tak campaign.
- The campaign aims to saturate 17 schemes of 9 Ministries in 75 selected districts across the country.
- Identified districts are aligned with birth place of 99 Freedom Fighters, who made the ultimate sacrifice for nation during India's struggle for independence.

2) National Pension Scheme

- Department of Posts has started providing National Pension Scheme services through online mode.
- Any Citizen of India in age group of 18 to 70 years can avail this online facility.
- NPS is voluntary Pension Scheme, regulated by Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA), through its designated post offices since 2010.

3) Zero Defect Zero Effect (ZED) Certification Scheme

- The Ministry of Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSME) launched a

4) Kwar Hydroelectric Project

- Cabinet has approved the 540 MW Kwar Hydroelectric Project in Kishtwar district of Jammu and Kashmir to harness the vast hydro potential of River Chenab.
- Chenab basin is estimated to have hydro power potential of around 11,283 MW.

1) Whitley Gold Award

- Charudutt Mishra, noted snow leopard expert and wildlife conservationist has won the prestigious Whitley Gold Award
- She got the awards for his contribution to involving indigenous communities in the conservation and recovery of big cat species in Asia's high mountain ecosystems. Princess Anne presented the award to Mishra at London's Royal Geographic Society.
- This is his second Whitley Fund for Nature (WFN) Award. He got the first in 2005.
