BRICS Summit Adopts Kazan Declaration

- The BRICS Summit (Brazil, Russia, India, China, South Africa) adopted the Kazan Declaration, focusing on reforms for the United Nations and multilateral institutions. The declaration supports member nations' aspirations to become permanent members of the UN Security Council.

Key Focus Areas of the Declaration

- **Global Governance Reforms:** BRICS emphasized the need to improve global governance, making international systems more inclusive, efficient, and representative of emerging markets and developing countries, particularly in Africa, Latin America, and the Caribbean.
- **Financial Cooperation:** The declaration highlighted cooperation in the financial sector, including payment settlements in national currencies, promoting a more flexible international financial system.
- **Climate Change and Biodiversity:** Climate change and biodiversity conservation were key areas of discussion, reaffirming the commitment to the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework.

The Indian community in Saudi Arabia presented a unique play featuring all 11 classical languages of India: Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Kannada, Marathi, Bengali, Assamese, Odia, Pali, Prakrit, and Sanskrit. Poetry recitals in Pali and Prakrit were particularly well-received.
- The inaugural day featured a quiz and a painting exhibition by women artists, further enriching the cultural experience.

India to Host 16th Edition of Women's Indian Open

- India is set to host the 16th edition of the Women's Indian Open golf tournament in Gurugram, Haryana. The event will feature 114 players from 31 nations, including 27 Indian golfers.

Key Indian Players

- Notable Indian participants include Hitaashee Bakshi, Vani Kapoor, Gaurika Bishnoi, Amandeep Drall, and Ridhima Dilawari. Diksha Dagar and Gaurika Bishnoi, who placed third and eighth respectively in the 2023 edition, will also compete.

International Participation

- The tournament will also see participation from three former champions: Christine Wolf, Camille Chevalier, and Caroline Hedwall.

Historical Context

- Aditi Ashok made history in 2016 by becoming the first Indian to win the Women's Indian Open, which has been India's most prestigious women's golf event since its inception in 2007.

Justice Yahya Afridi Appointed as Next Chief Justice of Pakistan

- Pakistani President Asif Ali Zardari has appointed Supreme Court Justice Yahya Afridi as the next Chief Justice of Pakistan, effective from October 26, 2024. This appointment will be for a fixed term of three years.

Constitutional Basis for Appointment

- The appointment is made under Articles 175A(3), 177, and 179 of the Constitution of Pakistan. The President's Office confirmed that Justice Afridi will take the oath of office on the same day.

Process of Appointment

- The appointment followed a recommendation from Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif to the President, based on a nomination from a parliamentary committee. This change in procedure resulted from a recent constitutional amendment granting the parliamentary committee the authority to select the Chief Justice from the three senior-most justices of the Supreme Court.

South Korea and US Conduct Joint Large-Scale Air Exercise

- South Korea and the United States have initiated a large-scale combined air exercise called Freedom Flag, aimed at enhancing readiness against threats from North Korea. The exercise commenced earlier this week and will last for 12 days.

Details of the Exercise

- The Freedom Flag exercise began on Monday across various air bases in South Korea, mobilizing approximately 110 aircraft. This includes South Korea's F-35A stealth fighters and F-15Ks, as well as US F-35Bs, F-16s, and MQ-9 drones. The Royal Australian Air Force is also participating with a KC-30A multi-role tanker transport aircraft.

Focus Areas and Training Objectives

- The exercise will initially focus on aircraft deployment and tactics planning, leading into next week's flight drills. These drills will involve training on defensive counter-air maneuvers and close air support.

Innovative Training Elements

- For the first time, the exercise will feature a joint flight involving fighter jets and unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), reflecting actual combat scenarios inspired by recent conflicts, such as the war in Ukraine. +

South Korea to Launch Third Military Spy Satellite

- South Korea is set to launch its third military reconnaissance satellite in December as part of its initiative to enhance surveillance capabilities over North Korea. The launch is scheduled for the third or fourth week of December and will utilize a SpaceX rocket.

Collaboration with SpaceX

- The Defense Acquisition Program Administration (DAPA) confirmed that it is coordinating with SpaceX to finalize launch details. This launch is part of South Korea's broader plan to deploy a total of five spy satellites by 2025.

Background on Previous Satellites

- South Korea's first two spy satellites were successfully launched aboard SpaceX rockets in December 2023 and April 2024. The first satellite is equipped with electro-optical and infrared sensors for detailed surface imaging, while the second satellite features synthetic aperture radar (SAR) sensors, enabling data collection under various weather conditions.

Future Surveillance Capabilities

- After launching all five spy satellites, the South Korean military aims to monitor specific targets in North Korea every two hours. Excluding the first satellite, the remaining four will be equipped with SAR sensors.

India Allocates 4.6% of GDP for Education from 2015 to 2024: UNESCO Report

- According to a UNESCO report, India earmarked approximately 4.1% to 4.6% of its Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for education between 2015 and 2024. This allocation aligns with the international benchmarks outlined in the UN's Education 2030 Framework for Action, which recommends that countries dedicate 4-6% of their GDP to educational initiatives.

Government Expenditure on Education

- The government expenditure on education in India ranged between 13.5% and 17.2% during the same period, reflecting a significant commitment to enhancing the educational landscape.

Focus on Sustainable Development Goals

- The reports, published by the UNESCO Institute for Statistics, emphasize global education investment trends, particularly in relation to achieving Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 4, which aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education for all.

Comparison with Other Countries

- India's investment in education, both as a percentage of GDP and in terms of government expenditure, is notably higher compared to other Central and Southern Asian countries.

Tennis World Bids Farewell to Dominic Thiem

- Dominic Thiem, the 2020 US Open champion, has officially announced his retirement from professional tennis.
- Thiem played his last professional match, where he was defeated by Luciano Darderi in the first round at the Erste Bank Open.
- He was also a runner-up at three Grand Slam tournaments: the French Open in 2018 and 2019, and the Australian Open in 2020.

Early Life and Career

- Dominic Thiem was born on September 3, 1993, in Austria. He rose to prominence in the tennis world and became known for his powerful playing style.

Professional Achievements

- Thiem achieved a career-high ranking of world No. 3 in singles, as recognized by the Association of Tennis Professionals, in March 2020. Throughout his career, he secured 17 ATP Tour singles titles.

Grand Slam Success

- Thiem won his first Grand Slam title at the 2020 US Open, where he made a remarkable comeback from two sets down to defeat Alexander Zverev in the final. This victory made him the first male player born in the 1990s to win a Major singles title and the first Austrian to win the US Open singles title.
