## Passage Exercise - PASSEX

- Indian Navy and Royal Bahrain Naval Force undertook Passage Exercise (PASSEX) in the Persian Gulf under Operation Sankalp.
- India's warship 'INS Talwar' took place in the exercise, while the RBNF was represented by the Corvette 'Al Muharrag'.

### Kuwait's Foreign Minister paid a 2-day visit to India

- Ahmed Nasser Al-Mohammad Al-Sabah paid a 2-day visit to India. Both the sides released a Joint Statement on the establishment of a Joint Ministerial **Commission** at the level of Foreign Ministers.
- JCM will act as an umbrella for all bilateral institutional engagements.

## Innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem

- A Statement of Intent was signed between The Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, and Amazon Internet Services Private Limited, a local legal Indian entity of Amazon Web Services to strengthen the innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem in India.
- It's objective is to empower school students with cloud computing skills.

### 'Sahi Disha' campaign

- The UNDP launched 'Sahi Disha' campaign to celebrate the livelihoods and entrepreneurship of women in rural India.
- The campaign aims to highlight the issues that affect the rural women's opportunity to access jobs, livelihood and to establish enterprises to become self-reliant.

### International Renewable Energy Agency Report
